





| | Medicine | | Radiation Vulnerability: How P53 Protein Dynamics May Prove to Be A Pathway For New Cancer Therapy | |



| Tuesday: February 16: 2021: Harvard Medical School Research | $|\dot{\alpha}|$. Exposure to radiation can wreak indiscriminate havoc on cells, tissues and organs. Curiously, however, some tissues are more vulnerable to radiation damage than others. Scientists have known these differences involve the protein p53, a well-studied tumour-suppressor protein, that initiates a cell's auto-destruct programmes.

Yet, levels of this sentinel protein are, often, similar in tissues with vastly different sensitivities to radiation, posing the question: How is p53 involved? A new Study by researchers in the Blavatnik Institute at Harvard Medical School, Massachusetts General Hospital and the Novartis Institutes for BioMedical Research now sheds light on this mystery. Reporting in Nature Communications on February 09, researchers describe how cellular survival after radiation exposure depends on behaviour of p53 over time.

In vulnerable tissues, p53 levels go up and remain high, leading to cell death. In tissues, that tend to survive radiation damage, p53 levels oscillate up and down. "Dynamics matter. How things change over time matters." said co-corresponding Author Professor Galit Lahav, the Novartis Professor of Systems Biology at HMS. "Our ability to understand biology is limited when we only

look at snapshots. By seeing how things evolve temporally, we gain much richer information, that can be critical for dissecting diseases and creating new therapies."

Notably, the findings suggest new strategies to improve combination therapies for cancer. The research team found certain types of tumours in mice were more vulnerable to radiation after being given a drug, that blocks p53 levels from declining and oscillating. Tumours treated this way shrunk significantly more than when given either radiation alone or the drug alone.

"We were able to connect differences in temporal p53 expression with radiation response and these insights allowed us to 'coax' radioresistant tumours into more radiosensitive ones." said co-corresponding author Professor Ralph Weissleder, the Thrall Family professor of Radiology and HMS professor of systems biology at Mass General. "This is an incredibly exciting Study showing that basic science done in rigorous quantitative fashion can lead to new important clinical discoveries."

When cells are exposed to ionising radiation, high-energy atomic particles haphazardly assault the delicate molecular machinery inside. If, this damage can not be repaired, particularly, to DNA, cells will self-destruct to protect the surrounding tissue and organism as a whole.

This act of cellular seppuku is regulated by p53, which acts as a sentinel for genomic damage. The protein is, also, a famous tumour suppressor, around half of human cancers have p53 mutations, that render it defective or sub-optimal. Previously, Professor Lahav and his colleagues showed the dynamic behaviour of p53 over time and how it affects cancer drug efficacy, cell fate and more.

In the current Study, Professors Lahav, Weissleder and their team looked at tissues in mice, that have very different sensitivities to ionising radiation, yet, are known to express comparable levels of p53, the spleen and thymus, which are highly vulnerable and the large and small intestines, which are more radioresistant.

Under normal conditions, cells express little to no p53. After radiation exposure, all four tissues expressed elevated p53 along with other markers of DNA and cellular damage as expected. But quantitative imaging analyses showed that p53 in the intestines peaked and then declined a few hours after irradiation. By contrast, p53 in the spleen and thymus remained high over the same time period.

To probe the effects of p53 behaviour, the researchers used an experimental anti-cancer drug to inhibit MDM2, a protein, that degrades p53. They found that by blocking MDM2 activity after radiation exposure, p53 could be forced to remain elevated in cells where it would otherwise decline. In the intestine, which is normally more resistant to radiation, the addition of the drug reduced cell viability and survival.

Some cancers can become resistant to radiation therapy. So, the research team explored whether manipulating p53 dynamics could increase tumour vulnerability, focusing on human colon cancer cell lines with unmutated, functional p53. In mice with transplanted human colon cancer tumours,

the researchers observed significant tumour shrinkage after a single dose of MDM2 inhibitor, given shortly after irradiation. After around six weeks, tumours treated with radiation and the drug together were five-times smaller than those treated with the drug alone and half the size of those treated with only with radiation.

"By irradiating first, we force the cancer cells to activate p53 and by adding MDM2 inhibitor on top of that, we can keep p53 active longer." Professor Lahav said. "This combination has a much stronger effect than either alone." The findings support the importance of understanding the dynamics of p53 and how to manipulate it to treat cancer.

Combination therapies using MDM2 inhibitors are currently being evaluated in clinical trials, the authors note, but these efforts are not designed to examine the underlying mechanisms and timing of the treatments. Further studies are needed to better understand p53 dynamics in cancer, which can inform how to better combine and time therapies to treat patients with cancer.

In addition, although, the researchers identified differences in p53 dynamics in different tissues after radiation exposure, the biological pathways, that lead to these differences remains a question for future study. "For a lab, studying p53, cancer is always a major motivation. Our goal is to acquire knowledge to help develop better and more efficient therapies." Professor Lahav said. "Understanding how p53 behaves over time in different conditions is a critical piece of the puzzle."

|| The World || COVAX AstraZeneca:Oxford COVID-19 Vaccine Delivery Logistics Underway in Earnest ||

The Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations:CEPI, Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance:Gavi and the World Health Organisation:WHO, as co-leads of the COVAX initiative for equitable global access to COVID-19 vaccines, alongside key delivery partner UNICEF, have welcomed the news that two versions of the AstraZeneca:Oxford COVID-19 vaccine have been given WHO Emergency Use Listing:EUL.

Yesterday's announcement means that two versions of the AstraZeneca:Oxford vaccine, produced by AstraZeneca-SK Bioscience:AZ-SKBio and the Serum Institute of India:AZ-SII, are now available for global rollout through the COVAX Facility. Building on the early information provided in the interim distribution forecast published on February 03, 2021, COVAX will now complete the process of final Q1:Q2 allocations of the AstraZeneca:Oxford vaccine to Facility participants. Information on these final allocations will be communicated to all participants and published online the week of February 22.

In order for doses to be delivered via this first allocation round, several critical pieces must be in place: All Facility participants must have given national regulatory authorisation for the vaccines in question, a process, which can be expedited by issuing special authorisations for use based on granting of WHO EUL.

All Facility participants must have signed indemnity agreements with the manufacturers in question in order to receive doses through COVAX. The COVAX Facility is helping to facilitate the process of getting these agreements in place. In particular, COVAX is supporting AMC-eligible participants by negotiating a template indemnity agreement on their behalf, saving time and resources and establishing a no-fault compensation mechanism and fund.

AMC-eligible economies must have submitted National Deployment and Vaccination Plans:NDVPs through the COVID-19 Partners Platform, that have then been reviewed and validated by COVAX.

In preparation for this unprecedented global rollout, COVAX partners have been working closely with all Facility participants for many months, providing support for regulatory and indemnity and liability issues, as well as, the submission of completed NDVPs. Throughout this process, Facility participants have been moving at speed to ensure all preparations are in place for the first deliveries.

As participants fulfil the above criteria and finalise readiness preparations, COVAX will issue purchase orders to the manufacturer and ship and deliver doses via an iterative process. This means deliveries for this first round of allocation will take place on a rolling basis and in tranches.

Due the high number of doses available, as well as, the high number of countries getting ready for delivery in Q1 2021, the capacity of supplier and freight forwarders will be under considerable pressure. Shipment timelines will be impacted by logistical preparedness and delivery lead times, which, may, vary, depending on the location of the receiving participant.

Based on this, COVAX anticipates the bulk of the first round of deliveries, taking place in March, with some early shipments to those, that have already fulfilled the criteria, occurring in late February. More information related to these first deliveries will be shared in the coming days.

|| The World || The World Health Organisation Launches Consolidated Guidelines For Malaria ||

The WHO Guidelines for Malaria, launched today, brings together the Organisation's most up-to-date recommendations for Malaria in one user-friendly and easy-to-navigate online platform. They are designed to support malaria-affected countries in their efforts to reduce and, ultimately, eliminate a disease, that continues to claim more than 400,000 lives each year.

Through the new platform, MAGICapp, users will find: All official WHO recommendations for Malaria prevention, vector control and preventive chemotherapies and case management, diagnosis and treatment. Recommendations for elimination settings are in development. Links to other resources, such as, guidance on the strategic use of information to drive impact; surveillance, monitoring and evaluation; operational manuals, handbooks and frameworks; and a glossary of key terms and definitions.

Users can access the evidence, that underpins each WHO recommendation through the new web-based platform. There is a feedback tab to help identify recommendations, that, may, need an update or further clarification and inputs from stake-holders are, also, welcome by email: gmpfeedback@who.int.

"These consolidated guidelines represent an important step in our efforts to deliver timely, evidence-based guidance to malaria-endemic countries." said Dr Pedro Alonso, the Director of the WHO Global Malaria Programme. "They will soon become a living resource, that is updated periodically as new evidence becomes available and as WHO guideline development groups bring forward proposals for new or revised recommendations."

The first version of the Guidelines for Malaria, available online only, is a compilation of existing WHO recommendations on Malaria and supersedes two previous WHO publications: the Guidelines for the Treatment of Malaria, third edition and the Guidelines for Malaria Vector Control. Four WHO guideline development groups focused on vector control, chemoprevention, treatment and elimination are currently convening to develop new or updated recommendations and other groups will convene this year to address additional relevant topics.

Recommendations on Malaria will continue to be reviewed and, where appropriate, updated based on the latest available evidence through WHO's transparent and rigorous guidelines review process. Any updated recommendations will always display the date of the most recent revision in the MAGICapp platform. With each update, a new PDF version of the consolidated guidelines will, also, be available for download on the WHO website.

Clear, evidence-informed WHO recommendations guide managers of national malaria programmes as they develop polices and strategic plans to combat the disease tailored to the local context; they support decisions around what to do. WHO, also, develops implementation guidance, such as, operational and field manuals, to advise countries on how to deliver the recommended tools and strategies.

The consolidation of WHO's Malaria guidelines is one of a number of actions the Organisation has undertaken in recent years to make its guidance more accessible to end users in malaria-endemic countries. The overall aim is to deliver timely, high quality recommendations through processes, that are more transparent, consistent, efficient and predictable.

A WHO guideline is defined broadly as any information product, developed by WHO, that contains recommendations for clinical practice or public health policy. A recommendation tells the intended end-user of a guideline what he or she can or should do in specific situations to achieve the best health outcomes possible, individually or collectively. It offers a choice among different interventions or measures having an anticipated positive impact on health and implications for the use of resources.

|| North America: USA || The Biden Administration Announces Extension of COVID-19 Forbearance and Foreclosure Protections For Millions of Homeowners and Renters ||

As millions of Americans face continued hardship from the COVID-19 pandemic, the US President Mr Biden is continuing to take action to help keep individuals and families in their homes. The COVID-19 pandemic has triggered a housing affordability crisis. According to the White House, today, one in five renters is behind on rent and just over 10 million homeowners are behind on mortgage payments. People of minorities face, even, greater hardship and are more likely to have deferred or missed payments, putting them at greater risk of eviction and foreclosure.

Today, as part of the President's commitment to deliver immediate relief for American families bearing the brunt of this crisis, the Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Department of Veterans Affairs and the Department of Agriculture announced a co-ordinated extension and expansion of forbearance and foreclosure relief programmes. These critical protections were due to expire in March, leaving many at risk of falling further into debt and losing

their homes. Now, homeowners will receive urgently needed relief as the country face this unprecedented national emergency.

Today's action builds on steps the President took on Day One to extend foreclosure moratoriums for federally guaranteed mortgages. The actions announced today will: Extend the foreclosure moratorium for homeowners through June 30, 2021; extend the mortgage payment forbearance enrolment window until June 30, 2021 for borrowers, who wish to request forbearance; provide up to six months of additional mortgage payment forbearance, in three-month increments, for borrowers, who entered forbearance on or before June 30, 2020.

The Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Department of Veterans Affairs and the Department of Agriculture worked in lock-step to make sure that these actions will reach the greatest number of Americans. Last week, the Federal Housing Finance Agency, the independent agency, that oversees Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac, extended forbearance by three months for borrowers coming to the end of their forbearance period. These co-ordinated actions will cover 70% of existing single-family home mortgages.

Mr Biden is committed to protecting homeownership and housing stability as America begins to turn a painful crisis into a robust recovery. Today's extended forbearance and foreclosure programmes are an important step towards building stronger and more equitable communities.

The White House says that to bolster these efforts, it is critical that Congress pass the American Rescue Plan to deliver more aid to struggling homeowners. The rescue plan creates a Homeowners Assistance Fund, which will provide states with \$10 billion to help struggling homeowners catch up on their mortgage payments and utility costs. This relief is critical for homeowners with mortgages in the private market, who are not able to take advantage of today's actions and may face longer term challenges.

The Biden-Harris Administration's priorities in extending these protections are to: Provide immediate relief to homeowners across America. Today's actions directly benefit the 02.7 million homeowners currently in COVID forbearance and extend the availability of forbearance options for nearly 11 million government-backed mortgages nationwide. Communities large and small need this assistance. That is why the Department of Housing and the Urban Development, Department of Veterans Affairs and the Department of Agriculture worked in concert to deliver across-the-board relief for urban, suburban, rural and military homeowners, including, seniors with reverse mortgages.

Support hard-hit communities of minorities. The health and economic costs of this crisis have not been evenly felt, a pattern repeated over the course of the pandemic. Extending forbearance policies will provide critical support to homeowners of minority communities, who make up a disproportionate share of borrowers with delinquent loans and loans in forbearance due to COVID-related hardship. On the first day of his Administration, the President Mr Biden committed to

advancing racial equity across all government programmes and policies. Today, agencies are stepping up with housing relief that will strengthen minority communities and build the foundation for an equitable recovery.

Provide a centralised resource for housing assistance. Homeowners and renters can visit consumerfinance.gov/housing for up-to-date information on their relief options, protections and key deadlines. As federal agencies continue working to implement housing assistance for American families, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau offers this website as a one-stop shop for both homeowners and renters to learn about programmes and resources, that can help them stay in their homes by reducing the risk of eviction and foreclosure.

| | Africa | | Armed Group Atrocities Creating Havoc in Eastern DRC: UNHCR Is Seeking \$195 Million to Support Its Vital Operations to Offer Support to the People in the Country | |



II Tuesday: February 16: 2021 II $\dot{\alpha}$. Atrocities, committed by armed groups in the eastern Democratic Republic of the Congo:DRC, have become part of a systematic pattern to disrupt lives, instil fear and create havoc, the UN refugee agency, UNHCR, said on Tuesday, expressing alarm

over the on-going situation. A record of more than 2,000 civilians were killed in three eastern provinces last year in attacks, mainly, attributed to armed groups, agency partners have reported.

The violence has continued into this year. The most recent incident occurred in late January, when two men were killed and six others were seriously injured, following an incursion into a site for forcibly displaced people in Masisi Territory, North Kivu province. UNHCR Spokesperson Mr Babor Baloch said that three people from the Kivuye displacement site, which is supported by the agency, were kidnapped in raids, carried out by an armed group a week ahead of the attack.

The armed group has, also, imposed a curfew in the area and visits homes to force residents to make 'security' payments. "UNHCR and its partners have heard numerous testimonies from people, who have survived this targeted violence. Between December 2020 and January 2021, at least, seven incursions by armed groups into five different sites have been reported in Masisi Territory." said Mr Baloch, speaking from Geneva.

In eastern DRC, UNHCR and the International Organisation for Migration:IOM are supporting 22 sites, home to more than 88,000 displaced people. Thousands more are living in spontaneous sites or, in host communities. "Attacks by armed groups are carried out on the suspicion of collaboration with other groups or the Congolese security forces." Mr Baloch said.

"Some of these sites are under threat from multiple armed groups. Civilians find themselves trapped in the middle of confrontations between different groups." UNHCR has, also, received reports of armed groups forcibly occupying schools and homes and attacking health centres." Mr Baloch said. Some have, also, imposed illegal taxes on villagers, who want to access their farms, thus, cutting them off from their only source of food and income.

"While the Congolese army's military operations against militia groups are more often successful than in the past, the armed forces do not have the capacity to maintain control of the areas they secure, thus, leaving space for armed actors to reclaim those areas and to impose themselves on the local population." he said.

UNHCR is working with local authorities and communities to protect civilians, while, also, closely monitoring the situation through its partners on the ground. The violence has uprooted more than five million people in the past two years, according to UN estimates but, UNHCR's efforts to assist them remain severely underfunded. The agency is seeking \$195 million to support its operations in the DRC but, so far, has received only six per cent of the funding.

| | Asia | | Military Coup in Myanmar: The Indiscriminate Use of Lethal Or Less-Than-Lethal Weapons Against Peaceful Protestors Is Unacceptable: More Violence Against Myanmar's People Will Only Compound the Illegitimacy of the Coup and the Culpability of Its Leaders: OHCHR | |

The UN Human Rights Office:OHCHR has expressed its alarm over the military coup in Myanmar in which the Army has taken over the reigns of power from the democratically elected government of Ms Aung San Suu Kyi. "The seizure of power by the Myanmar military earlier this month constitutes a profound setback for the country, after a decade of hard-won gains in its democratic transition. Those gains, which this Council reviewed less than three weeks ago in Myanmar's third UPR, had been reinforced by the clear results of the general elections of November 2020, now, effectively, betrayed by the coup and the declaration of a one-year State of Emergency." said Ms Nada Al-Nashif, the Deputy High Commissioner for Human Rights, in a statement to the Human Rights Council.

Protests across Myanmar have grown steadily since the February 01 military takeover and arrest of senior political leaders, including, the State Counsellor Ms Aung San Suu Kyi and the President Mr

Win Myint. "Myanmar's democratically elected political leadership, including, Aung San Suu Kyi and President U Win Myint, have been detained on politically motivated charges. Our Office is tracking more than 350 political and state officials, activists and civil society members, including, journalists, monks and students, who have been taken into custody. Several face criminal charges on dubious grounds. Most have received no form of due process and have not been permitted legal representation, family visitations or communication. Some remain missing, with no information as to their where-abouts or well-being."

In a conversation with the Deputy Commander-in-Chief of Myanmar Soe Win, UN Special Envoy Ms Christine Schraner Burgener reinforced the message that the right of peaceful assembly must fully be respected and that demonstrators were not subjected to reprisals. The UN Deputy Spokesman Mr Farhan Haq told reporters at a regular press briefing on Monday. "She has conveyed to the Myanmar military that the world is watching closely and any form of heavy-handed response is likely to have severe consequences." Mr Haq said.

In her conversation, Ms Schraner Burgener reiterated UN Secretary-General's statement on Sunday and called for a visit to the country under agreeable conditions. The Special Envoy will maintain this channel for frank and open dialogue so long as she assesses that it provides space for reversing the current situation and upholding the will of the people of Myanmar.

There have been reports of use of excessive force by police and military against demonstrators, as well as, of arbitrary detentions. An increased presence of security forces and armoured vehicles have, also, been reported in major cities. According to the UN human rights office:OHCHR, as of Friday, more than 350 political and state officials, activists and civil society members, including, journalists, monks and students, have been taken into custody. Several face criminal charges on dubious grounds and most have received no form of due process or permitted legal representation, family visitations or communication.

The military takeover followed escalating tensions between the military and the government after the November 2020 elections, which were won by Ms Suu Kyi-led National League for Democracy:NLD. The polls were only the second democratic elections in Myanmar since the end of nearly five decades of military rule.

"The High Commissioner and I greatly admire the conviction of the demonstrators, many of them young people and women, from diverse ethnic backgrounds, who have peacefully marched and participated in other activities to oppose the coup and the crackdown. It is they, who represent Myanmar's future: a future of shared justice and equitably shared national wealth, amid harmonious relationships between peoples and communities." Ms Nada Al-Nashif said in her statement.

"The world is watching. Draconian orders have been issued this week to prevent peaceful assembly and free expression and police and military presence on the streets has grown progressively over

the last several days. Following violent clashes with police on February 09, at least one woman is in critical condition. Pro-military and nationalist groups have also taken to the streets. Let us be clear: the indiscriminate use of lethal or less-than-lethal weapons against peaceful protestors is unacceptable. More violence against Myanmar's people will only compound the illegitimacy of the coup and the culpability of its leaders." she said.

"This crisis was born of impunity. Long-standing lack of civilian control over the military, its disproportionate influence in the country's political and economic structures and ongoing failure to genuinely account for crimes committed by the security forces over decades, have combined to compromise Myanmar's democratization and indeed, its development.

For over twenty years, successive High Commissioners and many eminent experts have briefed this Council, and its predecessor, on violations committed by the country's military, which include some of the most serious crimes alleged under international law. Lack of action to address them has emboldened military leaders and contributed to this present crisis." Ms Al-Nashif said.

"As this Council's own Fact Finding Mission warned explicitly in 2018, 'The Tatmadaw is the greatest impediment to Myanmar's development as a modern democratic nation. The Commander-in-Chief of the Tatmadaw, Min Aung Hlaing and all the current leadership must be replaced and a complete restructuring must be undertaken to place the Tatmadaw under full civilian control. Myanmar's democratic transition depends on it."

"Today, the democratic crisis that the people of Myanmar face is deepened by economic disaster wreaked by the pandemic. Already, COVID-19 has had profound impact, severely taxing a fragile health system and marginal social safety nets and driving millions of people into severe financial distress. The reckless actions of the military leadership raise the spectre of a reimposition of broad sanctions on the country – and could threaten many years of development gains." Ms Al-Nashif said in her statement.

"To the international community, I express my concern that any sanctions under consideration should be carefully targeted against specific individuals, who are credibly alleged to have violated people's rights. Leaders of this coup are an appropriate focus of such actions. It is of critical importance that no harm should be inflicted on the most vulnerable people in the country; and that assistance to help fight the pandemic can continue, alongside humanitarian support in conflict areas.

To this Council, we recommend the strongest possible call for the military authorities to respect the result of the election, to return power to civilian control and to immediately release all individuals arbitrarily detained. They should have prompt access to legal representation and medical support and specious criminal charges should be dropped. Internet and telecommunications restrictions must be lifted to allow media freedoms and access to information through the Internet. The

courageous human rights defenders, civil society and trade union movement that have emerged in recent years must be protected."

"Additionally, the military authorities must not be allowed to exacerbate the situation of the Rohingya people, after the extreme violence and decades of discrimination that they have endured. Myanmar must fully comply with the provisional measures ordered by the International Court of Justice, and move to genuinely address the root causes of conflicts in Rakhine State and other ethnic minority areas.

We regret that our Office has long been denied a presence in Myanmar, and urge the military authorities to grant OHCHR and the Special Rapporteur on the human rights situation in Myanmar full and immediate access.

To the people of Myanmar, we express our support for your rights to justice, to freedom, to democratic participation, to personal safety and security, and to peaceful, sustainable and inclusive development. We have been greatly moved by your determination – and also by the solidarity expressed by many members of ethnic groups who themselves have faced discrimination and violence." she said.

"The High Commissioner and I are hopeful that, from this crisis, you will be able to rebuild a country that rests on firmer democratic foundations, which can ensure the equality, dignity, human rights and the full inclusion of all in national development. And we are confident that the entire UN family, from its many teams on the ground to this Council and other bodies, will continue to stand together, with you, to uphold your legitimate aspirations for a free Myanmar."
