Il Tuesday: March 30: 2021 Il $\dot{\alpha}$. 25 heads of governments, including, Mr Boris Johnson, the UK Prime Minister, Dr Angela Merkel, the German Chancellor, Mr Emanuel Macron, the French President and Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, the Director-General of the World Health Organisation has written a joint statement, in which this new development has come into reality: these world leaders have presented the vital necessity and imperative for the world to, literally, come together to stand up to fight the common threats to all humanity by creating a well-resourced, well-architectured, well-equipped and with the vital powers, 'health architecture' for all the world and world humanity because the current state, as COVID-19 has shown absolutely clearly, is absolutely useless and it shall not do.

The world humanity must not be led to this same 'slaughter' again by another Pandemic and with the current one still raging and most of the world's humanity still are outside the vaccines. This is a good start. As the leaders expressed their hope that the international community should work together 'towards a new international treaty for pandemic preparedness and response' to build a more robust global health architecture that will protect future generations'. The world has been shown to have absolutely disarrayed and dysfunctional and it has cost humanity far too much: nearly three million people have been killed by this pandemic and the virus is still surging on across the planet. And, yet, despite we having many vaccines, for most of the world's humanity these vaccines still remain beyond them. This state of affairs can not go on and that is why it is a great thing that these leaders have responded to the desperation of the times and it is now everyone's duty to step up and join this work to get that treaty done; to get that architecture up and running.

The leaders have written:

COVID-19 shows why united action is needed for more robust international health architecture

The COVID-19 pandemic is the biggest challenge to the global community since the 1940s. At that time, following the devastation of two world wars, political leaders came together to forge the multilateral system. The aims were clear: to bring countries together, to dispel the temptations of isolationism and nationalism, and to address the challenges that could only be achieved together in the spirit of solidarity and cooperation, namely peace, prosperity, health and security.

Today, we hold the same hope that as we fight to overcome the COVID-19 pandemic together, we can build a more robust international health architecture that will protect future generations. There will be other pandemics and other major health emergencies. No single government or multilateral agency can address this threat alone. The question is not if, but when. Together, we must be better prepared to predict, prevent, detect, assess and effectively respond to pandemics in a highly coordinated fashion. The COVID-19 pandemic has been a stark and painful reminder that nobody is safe until everyone is safe.

We are, therefore, committed to ensuring universal and equitable access to safe, efficacious and affordable vaccines, medicines and diagnostics for this and future pandemics. Immunization is a

global public good and we will need to be able to develop, manufacture and deploy vaccines as quickly as possible.

This is why the Access to COVID-19 Tools Accelerator (ACT-A) was set up in order to promote equal access to tests, treatments and vaccines and support health systems across the globe. ACT-A has delivered on many aspects but equitable access is not achieved yet. There is more we can do to promote global access.

To that end, we believe that nations should work together towards a new international treaty for pandemic preparedness and response.

Such a renewed collective commitment would be a milestone in stepping up pandemic preparedness at the highest political level. It would be rooted in the constitution of the World Health Organization, drawing in other relevant organizations key to this endeavour, in support of the principle of health for all. Existing global health instruments, especially the International Health Regulations, would underpin such a treaty, ensuring a firm and tested foundation on which we can build and improve.

The main goal of this treaty would be to foster an all-of-government and all-of-society approach, strengthening national, regional and global capacities and resilience to future pandemics. This includes greatly enhancing international cooperation to improve, for example, alert systems, datasharing, research, and local, regional and global production and distribution of medical and public health counter measures, such as vaccines, medicines, diagnostics and personal protective equipment.

It would also include recognition of a "One Health" approach that connects the health of humans, animals and our planet. And such a treaty should lead to more mutual accountability and shared responsibility, transparency and cooperation within the international system and with its rules and norms.

To achieve this, we will work with Heads of State and governments globally and all stakeholders, including civil society and the private sector. We are convinced that it is our responsibility, as leaders of nations and international institutions, to ensure that the world learns the lessons of the COVID-19 pandemic.

At a time when COVID-19 has exploited our weaknesses and divisions, we must seize this opportunity and come together as a global community for peaceful cooperation that extends beyond this crisis. Building our capacities and systems to do this will take time and require a sustained political, financial and societal commitment over many years.

Our solidarity in ensuring that the world is better prepared will be our legacy that protects our children and grandchildren and minimizes the impact of future pandemics on our economies and our societies.

Pandemic preparedness needs global leadership for a global health system fit for this millennium. To make this commitment a reality, we must be guided by solidarity, fairness, transparency, inclusiveness and equity.

"This powerful idea, of a treaty, rooted in WHO, has resulted in the joint statement, issued today and published in major newspapers around the world and in multiple languages, which has been signed, so far, by twenty-five heads of state and heads of government. They represent a diversity of countries, from north and south, east and west." Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, the Director-General of the World Health Organisation:WHO has said today at a press conference with Mr Charles Michel, the President of the European Council to discuss the proposal for an international pandemic treaty.

Dr Tedros said that without an internationally co-ordinated, all-of-government, all-of-society, One Health approach to pandemic preparedness and response, we remain vulnerable. It has shown how much we need a universal commitment to basic public health principles as the foundation for our work to prevent, detect and respond to epidemic and pandemic threats." "It is now 425 days since I declared COVID-19 a global health emergency. In that time, the COVID-19 pandemic has brought out the best and worst in humanity. We have seen acts of incredible courage from health workers and from communities around the world, on a daily basis. But the pandemic has, also, thrived amid the inequalities in our societies, the geo-political fault lines in our world and the frayed trust in our public institutions.

It has exposed the gaps in national, regional and global preparedness and response systems but, also, allowed us to identify opportunities to strengthen the international health architecture." Dr Tedros said.

He said that the time to act was now. The world could not afford to wait until the pandemic is over to start planning for the next one. The world must not allow the memories of this crisis to fade and go back to business as usual. "The impacts on our societies, economies and health, especially, for the poor and the most vulnerable, are too significant. We can not do things the way we have done them before and expect a different result. We must act boldly."

"The idea behind the proposal for such as treaty is to systematically tackle the gaps exposed by COVID-19. The world has come together as never before to take on this crisis. Now, we must leverage the new opportunities for global co-operation and innovation. This treaty would strengthen the implementation of the International Health Regulations and, critically, it would, also, provide a framework for international co-operation and solidarity. "

Dr Tedros made the point that the key issues it would address could include building resilience to pandemics and other global health emergencies, with robust national and global preparedness systems; ensuring timely and equitable access to pandemic countermeasures, including, vaccines; supporting sustainable funding and capacity for prevention, detection, and responses to outbreaks; and promote mutual trust.

"The treaty, which could be taken forward by the World Health Assembly, would be based on the WHO Constitution, including, the principles of health for all and non-discrimination. Ultimately,

of course, how such a treaty is developed and what it looks like and whether it is ratified, is a matter for our Member States, the nations of the world. We must leave a legacy for our children: a safer world for all."

| | Medicine | | Researchers Show SARS-CoV-2 Distribution and Relation to Tissue Damage in COVID-19 Patients | |

The first known Study to measure SARS-CoV-2 viral load in a variety of organs and tissues may aid our understanding of how COVID-19 develops following infection. Researchers have mapped the distribution of SARS-CoV-2, the virus, that causes COVID-19, in deceased patients with the disease and shed new light on how viral load relates to tissue damage.

Their study of 11 autopsy cases, published today in eLife, may contribute to our understanding of how COVID-19 develops in the body following infection. More than 24 million SARS-CoV-2 infections have been reported to date and the number of deaths by the disease are now reaching towards three million worldwide. COVID-19 occurs with varying degrees of severity. While most patients have mild symptoms, some experience more severe symptoms and may need to be hospitalised.

A minority of those in hospital may enter a critical condition, with respiratory failure, blood vessel complications or multiple organ dysfunction. "Clinical observations suggest that COVID-19 is a systemic disease, meaning that it affects the entire body rather than just a single organ such as the lungs." explains co-first author Ms Stefanie Deinhardt-Emmer, the Resident in Medical Microbiology, Jena University Hospital, Jena, Germany.

"But we don't currently have a clear understanding of disease development in humans and other organisms, due to the lack of appropriate experimental models. Investigating the viral distribution of SARS-CoV-2 within the human body and how this relates to tissue damage would help us address this gap."

To do this, Ms Deinhardt-Emmer and colleagues studied 11 autopsy cases of patients with COVID-19. They performed the autopsies at the early post-mortem stage to minimise bias due to the degradation of tissues and viral ribonucleic acid:RNA, a molecule similar to DNA.

Their analysis showed high viral loads in most of the patients' lungs, which had caused significant damage to those organs. Using an imaging technique, called, transmission electron microscopy, the Research Team, also, visualised intact viral particles in the lung tissue.

"Interestingly, we, also, detected SARS-CoV-2 RNA throughout various other tissues and organs unrelated to the lungs, that did not cause visible tissue damage." says co-first author Mr Daniel Wittschieber, the Senior Forensic Pathologist at Jena University Hospital. The researchers say that this distribution of viral RNA throughout the body supports the idea that our immune system is unable to respond adequately to the virus' presence in the blood.

"We show that COVID-19 is a systemic disease as determined by the presence of virus RNA and, yet, unrelated to tissue damage outside the lungs." says co-senior author Ms Bettina Löffler, the Director of the Institute for Medical Microbiology, Jena University Hospital. "To our knowledge, this Study is the only one to date, that has measured viral loads in a wide variety of organs and tissues, with more than 60 samples studied per patient."

"The insights gathered from our work may add to our understanding of how COVID-19 develops in the body following infection." concludes co-senior author Ms Gita Mall, the Head of the Institute of Forensic Medicine, Jena University Hospital.

| | The World | | COVID-19 Origins Report Inconclusive: We Must Leave No Stone Unturned: Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus: And No Power Must Be Tolerated to Hinder That Effort for the World to Get to the Truth: The Humanion | |



Health Organisation: WHO to examine how COVID-19 first spread to humans was published on Tuesday and was described by WHO's Director-General Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus as a welcome start but far from conclusive. "This Report is a very important beginning but it is not the end." he said. "We have not yet found the source of the virus and we must continue to follow the science and leave no stone unturned as we do."

Dr Tedros welcomed the findings of the 34-member team, which in January, visited the Chinese city of Wuhan where the first cases of the then new coronavirus came to light at the end of 2019. But he was clear that, overall, it raises further questions, that will need to be addressed by further

studies, as the team itself notes in the Report. He noted that, although, much data had been provided, to fully understand the earliest cases, they would need access from Chinese authorities to data, including, biological samples from, at least, September 2019.

"In my discussions with the team, they expressed the difficulties they encountered in accessing raw data. I expect future collaborative studies to include more timely and comprehensive data sharing." Dr Tedros welcomed the recommendations for further studies to understand the earliest human cases and clusters and to trace animals sold at markets in and around Wuhan, but the role of animal markets is still unclear.

The team confirmed that there had been widespread contamination in the large market of Huanan but could not determine the source of this contamination. "Again, I welcome the recommendations for further research, including, a full analysis of the trade in animals and products in markets across Wuhan, particularly, those linked to early human cases." he said.

He agreed that farmers, suppliers and their contacts should be interviewed and that more study was needed to identify what role farmed wild animals may have played in introducing the virus to markets in Wuhan and beyond.


The team, also, visited several laboratories in Wuhan and considered the possibility that the virus had entered the human population as a result of a laboratory incident. "However, I do not believe that this assessment was extensive enough. Further data and studies will be needed to reach more robust conclusions." he said.

"Although, the team has concluded that a laboratory leak is the least likely hypothesis, this requires further investigation, potentially, with additional missions, involving specialist experts, which I am ready to deploy. As far as WHO is concerned, all hypotheses remain on the table." he told the Member State briefing on the Report in Geneva.

"Finding the origin of a virus takes time and we owe it to the world to find the source so we can collectively take steps to reduce the risk of this happening again. No single research trip can provide all the answers."

| | Political Economics | | Voltalia Has Won the Contract for the Construction and Operation of a 100MW Solar Plant in Albania: The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development Supported Its Bid | |

The French renewables company Voltalia has won the contract for the construction and operation of a 100MW solar plant in Albania following its successful bid in a tender run by the Albanian Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy. The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development:EBRD supported the tender by providing technical assistance.

The new plant, located in the area of Spitallë, in the coastal municipality of Durrës in the west of the country, will diversify energy supply and increase energy security while delivering climate-neutral energy at an affordable price. Mr Harry Boyd-Carpenter, EBRD Director, Energy Europe, Middle East and Africa, said, "The tender attracted high-quality foreign investment and will deliver solar power at a really competitive price. Delivering a tariff below €30 per MWh for wholesale electricity is stunning. This is a fantastic result for Albania and for the Western Balkans overall."

The tender builds on the success of a previous competitive bidding process for solar power, supported by the EBRD in Albania at the coastal site of Karavasta, where Voltalia has won the tender to build and operate a 140MW solar plant.

It replicates that successful model in support of the development of the local electricity market; part of the electricity produced at the new solar park will benefit from a guaranteed tariff, while part will be sold directly on the free market. EBRD policy engagement to implement the necessary regulatory changes is expected to help attract more investment in the future.

Mr Matteo Colangeli, EBRD Head of Albania, said, "The tender delivered another landmark for the development of solar power in Albania and will attract more high-quality foreign direct investment to the country. We are proud to be supporting Albania on the path to a sustainable and diversified energy sector."

Albania is a mountainous country and its abundance of water resources has made it dependent on hydropower for electricity generation. The need to diversify its energy sources has been recognised as a policy priority, with a view to increasing climate change resilience and decreasing dependency on electricity imports. The country is committed to developing its solar and wind power potential.

The EBRD has been promoting the scale-up of this process through policy dialogue, technical assistance and investment. The Bank is, also, supporting Albania in launching the Country's first auction for utility-scale on-shore wind power plants, expected in the weeks ahead. Projects totalling 150MW of capacity will be eligible under the renewable-energy support scheme run by Albania's Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy. The Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs:SECO has provided grant funding to support the wind auction. To date, EBRD has invested more than €01.5 billion in 110 projects in Albania.


