| | United Kingdom | | Deprivation Is Driving COVID-19 Ethnic Disparities: Inequalities in Health Or Health Behaviours in People Living With High Deprivation Are in the Most Part the Result of the High Deprivation Itself: New Research | |

Deprivation, among society at large, is driving COVID-19 disparities among minority ethnic groups, predominantly, South Asian and Black African or Caribbean populations and could be considered the main cause of disproportionate infection rates, hospitalisation and deaths experienced by these populations, according to new analysis from the University of Leicester. This comes a day after a government-commissioned review concluding race and racism have become less important factors in explaining social disparities in the UK.

Researchers at the University of Leicester used UK Biobank data of 407,830 South Asian, Black and White individuals to model a hypothetical intervention whereby 50% of the general population were lifted out of material deprivation status, the 'grade' of deprivation was measured by the highly regarded Townsend score, that is made up of four domains: unemployment, non-car ownership, non-home ownership and household overcrowding. The Study has been supported by the National Institute for Health Research:NIHR Leicester Biomedical Research Centre:BRC.

By moving the 50% most deprived in the general population sample out of material deprivation, over 80% of the extra, 'excess' risk of COVID-19 outcomes for South Asian and Black populations was eliminated. Even, just by moving 25% of the sample out of deprivation, between 40 and 50 per cent of additional risk to South Asian and Black populations was alleviated.

The striking results of this large, unprecedented analysis dispute several existing studies, some of which maintain that poorer health among ethnic minority populations could be the driving factor for COVID-19 disparities. Mr Cameron Razieh, the Lead Author of the analysis and an Epidemiologist at the University of Leicester, specialises in ethnic minority health conditions.

He says, "The method of analysis we used in this Study upholds that inequalities in health or health behaviours in people living with high deprivation are, in the most part, the result of the high deprivation itself. If, we take this as truth, then, we can conclude that high levels of deprivation are helping drive COVID-19 ethnic disparities. Reducing deprivation within the whole population could, therefore, play a pivotal role in reducing ethnic inequalities in COVID-19 outcomes observed in South Asian and Black communities."

Professor Kamlesh Khunti, the Joint Senior Author of the Study, who, also, works as Director of the UK NIHR Applied Research Collaborations East Midlands: ARCEM, said, "Material deprivation is a universal underpinning determinant of health inequalities within and between populations. Quantifying the extent to which material deprivation reduces risk is important but, even, more imperative is to now ask how we can reduce social inequality and increase social mobility. There is a rapidly closing window to use research evidence, such as this, to give those most in need a fighting chance to better manage their health."

Joint Senior Author Professor Tom Yates, of Physical Activity, Sedentary Behaviour and Health at the University of Leicester, said, "The data from this Study calls for improved assistance to be provided to the poorest communities. In what we hope is the final stretch of this pandemic we must now pull together, backed by research, to ensure that for those most at risk of COVID-19 outcomes, there is still light at the end of this very long tunnel.

Mediation analysis report key information

::: 15,044, 53.0%, women, South Asian and Black and 392,786, 55.2%, women, White individuals were included in the Study.

::: There were, 151, 01.0% positive tests, 91, 0.6% severe cases and 31, 0.2%, deaths due to COVID-19 in South Asian and Black individuals compared to 1,471, 0.4%, 895, 0.2% and 313, 0.1%, respectively, in White individuals.

::: Compared to White individuals, the relative risk of testing positive for COVID-19, developing severe disease and COVID-19 mortality in South Asian and Black individuals were 02.73: 95% CI: 02.26, 03.19; 02.96: 02.31, 03.61 and 04.04: 02.54, 05.55, respectively.

South Asian and Black individuals were analysed as a single ethnic minority group. This approach was subject to a sensitivity analysis. Other minority ethnic groups, including, those self-reporting a mixed ethnicity, were not included due to low numbers and existing evidence that the risk of COVID-19 outcomes is highest for South Asian and Black individuals.

For this analysis, the mediator, material deprivation, was included as a binary variable, categorised at the 75th percentile of the Townsend score, value = 0.4. It has previously been shown that the Townsend score at the area level correlates strongly with measures of deprivation at the individual level.


The full analysis of 'Ethnic minorities and COVID-19: Examining whether excess risk is mediated through deprivation' is published in the European Journal of Public Health.

UK Biobank uses a large prospective cohort of middle-aged adults, designed to support health research, focused on improving the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of chronic diseases. In this Study, UK Biobank data was used with linked COVID-19 outcomes occurring between March 16, 2020 and August 24, 2020.

# | | Jurisprudence: UN Human Rights and Refugee Agencies Call On the Countries in the Region to Protect All Those Fleeing Myanmar | |

The United Nations Office of the High Commissioner of Human Rights:OHCHR and the UN High Commissioner of Refugees:UNHCR have called on Myanmar's neighbouring countries to offer refuge and protection to people, fleeing violence and persecution as the crisis in Myanmar enters its third month. In addition to the political strife across the country, renewed fighting between Myanmar's military and ethnic armed organisations in some border areas, including, airstrikes in Kayin province, are driving people to flee within the country and across borders.

Ms Gillian Triggs, the Assistant High Commissioner for Protection at UNHCR, said in a press note that it was vital that anyone crossing the border, seeking asylum in another country, was able to access it. "Children, women and men fleeing for their lives should be given sanctuary. They must not be returned to a place where their lives or freedom may be at risk. This principle of non-refoulement is a cornerstone of international law and is binding on all states." she said.

The situation across Myanmar has deteriorated rapidly since the military coup on February 01. According to OHCHR, at least, 510 peaceful protesters have been killed by the security forces and over 2,600 are in detentions, including, many held incommunicado or forcibly disappeared.

"Night raids, mass arrests and killings have become daily occurrences throughout the country." OHCHR South-East Asia Regional Office said in a news release on Thursday. "De facto military authorities have increasingly resorted to heavy weaponry, such as, rocket-propelled and fragmentation grenades, heavy machine guns and snipers to kill demonstrators in massive numbers."

The crackdown has, also, claimed the lives of, at least, 35 children and left countless more with serious injuries. Millions have been directly or indirectly exposed to traumatising scenes of violence, threatening their mental health and emotional well-being, UN Children's Fund:UNICEF said earlier this week.

On Wednesday, Ms Christine Schraner Burgener, UN Special Envoy on Myanmar, warned that the security and economic consequences of the crisis in the wider region are worsening and the influx of refugees at the Indian and Thai borders, as well as, elsewhere ominous and likely just the beginning. OHCHR said that it received reports that some individuals, who fled Myanmar in search of safety in the region have been forced to return to the country.

Ms Cynthia Veliko, South-East Asia Regional Representative of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights said that no one should face the risk of being returned to Myanmar when their lives, safety or fundamental human rights were threatened. "In light of binding obligations under international refugee and human rights law, we call on all countries to ensure that all those seeking asylum are able to access the protection to which they are entitled under international law." she said. "Now is the time for us to stand in solidarity with the people of Myanmar."

States in the region should, also, ensure effective search and rescue and refrain from intercepting or pushing back those, who are trying to access sea or land routes to reach safety, the UN human rights office added. UNHCR Assistant High Commissioner Ms Triggs highlighted that Myanmar's neighbours have a decades-long history of providing protection and assistance to refugees.

"As the situation in Myanmar deteriorates further, we call on states to continue their lifesaving humanitarian tradition of safeguarding the lives of all those forced to flee." she urged. Ms Triggs noted that it was a proven fact that humane border practices can be upheld amid public health and other border control measures, to ensure that people in need of protection could access territory and asylum.

"Across the region, UNHCR and partner organisations stand ready to step-up support to national and local authorities to ensure that refugees receive the protection they needed." she said.

The UN human rights office, also, urged countries to put in place measures to ensure migrants from Myanmar, millions of whom live and work across the region, do not fall into situations of irregularity, as many may be fearful of returning to renew their visas. "We call on countries in the region to suspend deportations of Myanmar migrants, who are undocumented or otherwise in

irregular situations and to provide them with a secure legal status while their country remains in crisis." Ms Veliko said.

# | | Medicine | | Selenium Supplementation Is Found to Protect Against Obesity and May Extend Life-Span in Mice: And It May Hold True for Human Health | |



Harsday: April 01: 2021 H lpha. Adding the nutrient selenium to diets protects against obesity and provides metabolic benefits to mice, according to a Study, published on March 30 in eLife. The results could lead to interventions, that reproduce many of the anti-aging effects, associated with dietary restriction while, also, allowing people to eat as normal. Several types of diet have been shown to increase health-span, that is, the period of healthy lifespan.

One of the proven methods of increasing health-span in many organisms, including, non-human mammals, is to restrict dietary intake of an amino acid, called, methionine. Recent studies have suggested that the effects of methionine restriction on health-span are likely to be conserved in humans. Although, it might be feasible for some people to practice methionine restriction, for example, by adhering to a vegan diet, such a diet might not be practical or desirable for everyone.

In the current study, a research team from the Orentreich Foundation for the Advancement of Science:OFAS, Cold Spring, New York, US, aimed to develop an intervention, that produces the same effects as methionine restriction, while allowing an individual to eat a normal, unrestricted diet.

An important clue for developing such a treatment is that methionine restriction causes a decrease in the amounts of an energy-regulating hormone, IGF-1. If, a treatment could be found, that causes a similar decrease in IGF-1, this might, also, have beneficial effects on health-span. Previous research has shown that selenium supplementation reduces the levels of circulating IGF-1 in rats, suggesting that this could be an ideal candidate.

The research team first studied whether selenium supplementation offered the same protection against obesity as methionine restriction. They fed young male and older female mice one of three high-fat diets: a control diet, containing typical amounts of methionine, a methionine-restricted diet and a diet, containing typical amounts of methionine, as well as, a source of selenium. For both male and female mice of any age, the authors found that selenium supplementation completely protected them against the dramatic weight gain and fat accumulation, seen in mice, fed the control diet and to the same extent as restricting methionine.

Next, they explored the effects of the three diets on physiological changes, normally associated with methionine restriction. To do this, they measured the amounts of four metabolic markers in blood samples from the previously treated mice. As hoped, they found dramatically reduced levels of IGF-1 in both male and female mice. They, also, saw reductions in the levels of the hormone leptin, which controls food intake and energy expenditure. Their results indicate that selenium supplementation produces most, if, not all, of the hallmarks of methionine restriction, which suggests that this intervention may have a similar positive effect on health-span.

To gain insight into the beneficial effects of selenium supplementation, the researchers used a different organism, yeast. The two most widely used measurements of health-span in yeast are chronological lifespan, which tells us how long dormant yeast remain viable and replicative lifespan, which measures the number of times a yeast cell can produce new off-spring. The researchers previously showed that methionine restriction increased the chronological life-span of yeast, so they tested whether selenium supplementation might do the same. As it turned out, yeast grown under selenium-supplemented conditions had a 62% longer chronological life-span, from 13 days to 21 days and a replicative life-span extended by nine generations as compared with controls. This demonstrates that supplementing yeast with selenium produces benefits to health-span, detectable by multiple tests of cell aging.

"One of the major goals of aging research is to identify simple interventions, that promote human health-span." says Senior Author Jay Johnson, Senior Scientist at OFAS. "Here we present evidence that short-term administration of either organic or inorganic sources of selenium provides multiple health benefits to mice, the most notable of which being, the prevention of diet-induced obesity. In

the long term, we expect that supplementation with these compounds will, also, prevent agerelated disease and extend the overall survival of mice. It is our hope that many of the benefits observed for mice will, also, hold true for humans."

## | | Political Economics | | US: Energy Transition to Renewables Is Likely to Accelerate Over the Next Two to Three Years: Coal Must Go | |

'US Power Sector Outlook 2021', published by the Institute for Energy Economics and Financial Analysis:IEEFA, finds that the speed and scope of the energy transition to renewables will pick up pace over the next two to three years. Solar and battery storage adoption is enjoying, almost, exponential growth and wind and solar technology improvements have helped turn the two resources into the least-costly option across the United States.

Even, a short-term increase in coal generation, caused by higher gas prices is likely to be just that, a short-term increase. IEEFA's analysis expects that coal's share of the US generation sector still could fall to 10% by 2025. The increase in renewables is happening largely at the expense of coal. Wind capacity has doubled since 2012 and solar capacity has doubled since 2016. Utility-scale wind and solar accounted for more than 10% of total US electricity generation in 2020 for the first time.

"Coal will be pushed out of the electricity sector completely, with gas set to decline as well." said Mr Dennis Wamsted, an IEEFA Analyst and the Report Co-author. "Cleaner and lower-cost wind and solar, coupled with battery storage, will drive fossil fuels out of the market."

"This is just the start of a transition, that is rapidly accelerating, driven by sharp declines in cost, stricter environmental regulations for coal generation and mounting public concern about climate change." said Mr David Schlissel, IEEFA Director of Resource Planning Analysis and the Report's Co-author.

The 2021 Power Outlook observed that changes in Texas may be most indicative of changes happening in the electric sector. At the end of 2011, the state's installed wind capacity was 9,603 megawatts:MW, making up 08.5% of the region's electricity demand. By the end of 2020, installed wind capacity had climbed to 25,121MW, reaching a 22.8% market share. Coal generation, which had accounted for 39% of electricity needs in 2011, fell to 17.9% in 2020.

"The Texas transition will not be replicated precisely in other areas of the country but, the broad themes are certainly going to hold true, particularly, the surge in new wind and solar generation through 2024." said Mr Seth Feaster, an IEEFA Energy Data Analyst and the Report's Co-author.



# | | Political Economics | | Committing to Green: EBRD Will Help Kazakhstan Achieve Carbon Neutrality by 2060 | |

The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development: EBRD and Kazakhstan have agreed to develop a long-term co-operation strategy to achieve carbon neutrality of the country's power sector by 2060. The Accord will further cement Kazakhstan's status as a regional renewable energy leader in Central Asia.

The roadmap for the decarbonisation strategy was signed by Kazakhstan's Minister of Energy Nurlan Nogayev and by EBRD President Odile Renaud-Basso during her first visit to Central Asia's largest state. EBRD and Kazakhstan will co-operate, among other things, on the development of renewable energy and the carbon market, the enhancement of the electrical grid and the decommissioning of old thermal capacity.

The Bank is committed to financing renewable energy projects, implemented through an auction mechanism in order to promote competitive pricing and to stimulate investment in renewable energy. EBRD President said, "We are pleased to help Kazakhstan develop its energy sector in line with the global decarbonisation agenda.

Our partnership in the area of sustainable energy began over a decade ago and, based on the country's achievements to date, Kazakhstan is right on track to achieve the new ambitious target of carbon neutrality."


Kazakhstan's Minister of Energy said, "Long-standing co-operation with the EBRD is helping us achieve our development goals in the energy sector. Jointly, we search for innovative solutions to enable the sector's sustainable development and this is an important foundation for our present and future work. Today's memorandum will shape our cooperation for years to come."

EBRD remains a committed supporter of the country's renewable energy drive, with 14 projects worth \$535 million financed to date. In 2020 alone and despite the COVID-19 pandemic's effect on the economy, EBRD allocated \$53 million to supporting the construction of a 100MW wind farm near the city of Zhanatas and a 76MW solar power plant in the Karaganda region.

To date, EBRD has invested more than €08.13 billion in the economy of Kazakhstan through 280 projects. Support for small businesses is, particularly, important and is in line with EBRD's country strategy for Kazakhstan.



Applications are open for the European Space Agency:ESA's first astronaut selection in over a decade and all qualified candidates are encouraged to put themselves forward. Vacancy notices Astronaut and Astronaut with a physical disability, have been posted to jobs.esa.int. Applications must be submitted via this site before May 28, 2021 to be considered for selection and important information for candidates is available in the newly released Astronaut Applicant Handbook.

Therefore, all remains to be done by all the future astronauts is to apply right on time: 07, 06, 05, 04, 03, 02....And lift off! Thunderbird to go! Who knows, they, ESA, that is, might go to hibernation for another decade, following their record, before they woke up to recruit again! Therefore, go: who knows, you might end up walking on Mars! Becoming an ESA astronaut is no easy feat but the only guaranteed way for those, who meet the minimum requirements to miss out on selection is to not submit an application. This message has been reiterated by the ESA astronaut class of 2009, including, the soon-to-fly Mr Thomas Pesquet, remember him, who said not applying in ESA's last selection round would have been 'the biggest mistake of my life'.



"The most selective step is whether or not you are going to apply." Mr Pesquet says. "There's maybe one in a thousand people, who are going to be picked up, but there is one in a million, who will apply. So please, please, apply, apply, apply."

Mr Pesquet is scheduled to launch to the International Space Station for his second mission, known as Alpha, on April 22, 2021. The first mission of ESA astronaut Mr Matthias Maurer is scheduled for October and ESA astronaut Ms Samantha Cristoforetti expected to launch on her second mission in spring 2022. Remember, they all had to apply in order get into the programme to train to be astronauts!

In a recent ESA Explores podcast interview, ESA Director of Human and Robotic Exploration Nr David Parker said that the development of new human-rated spacecraft present, even, more opportunities for European astronauts to travel to the International Space Station and beyond, as the Agency entered a new decade of space exploration.

"Not only will we continue to live and work in low Earth orbit on board the Space Station for perhaps another 10 years, we, also, have concrete opportunities to fly astronauts to new destinations." he said. "We need to keep our eyes on our aim of living and working on the lunar Gateway, then the Moon and who knows, maybe, even, one day, the surface of Mars. This new group of recruits will help keep our astronaut corps at full strength, ready for an exciting future."

One new aspect of this astronaut selection campaign is the introduction of the 'Parastronaut Fly! Feasibility Project'. To help increase accessibility of spaceflight for all qualified Europeans, ESA is seeking candidates, living with a specific physical disability to help assess the technologies and

adaptations required to one day send an astronaut with a physical disability on a professional space mission.


"This hasn't been attempted or considered before but, for me it is really important because European astronauts represent the best of Europe. There could be an excellent scientist or engineer, who just happens to live with a physical disability."

"We did not evolve to go to space, so when it comes to space travel, we are all disabled." ESA Astronaut Ms Samantha Cristoforetti says. "What brings us from being disabled to go to space to being able to go to space is just technology. This is a feasibility study and we're going to look into what exactly is needed, how much it will cost but that's the goal."

| | Jurisprudence | | Papua New Guinea's Universal Periodic Review: The Papua New Guinea Government Has Failed to Live Up to Its Commitments on the Rights of Women and Children and On Police Accountability: Human Rights Watch | |

The Papua New Guinea government has failed to live up to commitments on women's rights, children's rights and police accountability, Human Rights Watch said in a recent submission to the United Nations Human Rights Council. Papua New Guinea's Universal Periodic Review: UPR of its human rights situation before the council has been scheduled for November 2021.

"Papua New Guinea has made big promises to the UN but failed to meet them." said Ms Elaine Pearson, the Australia Director at Human Rights Watch. "During the review, UN member countries should remind the Papua New Guinea government that it needs to do much better, especially, to defend the basic rights of women and children and to investigate and prosecute police brutality."

Under the UPR system, the UN Human Rights Council in Geneva reviews each country's human rights record every five years. During the previous cycle, in 2016, Papua New Guinea accepted numerous recommendations.

It pledged to take steps to protect the rights of women and girls; to investigate gender-based violence, including, accusations of sorcery; to increase access to education and to ensure that police officers are held to account for abuses. However, the government has failed to show progress on these key issues.


The submission, also, covers the death penalty, disability rights, the rights of LGBT people and refugee rights, given that 130 refugees and asylum seekers remain in Papua New Guinea, transferred there by the Australian government since 2013.


