COVID-19 has unfairly impacted some people more harshly than others, exacerbating existing inequities in health and welfare within and between countries. For World Health Day, April 07, the World Health Organisation has called for urgent action to improve health for all people. Within countries, illness and death from COVID-19 have been higher among groups, who face discrimination, poverty, social exclusion and adverse daily living and working conditions, including, humanitarian crises. Furthermore, the world, the entire body of science and the whole world's governments must answer as to what poverty, hunger and malnutrition do to human physiologies? What these do to the babies growing in the wombs of the mothers, who are suffering poverty, hunger and malnutrition? What poverty, hunger and malnutrition do to human health, growth and development and how that determines not only the life-span but, also, the ultimate quality of that life, that these people are destined to suffer and live by?

There can not be any health unless poverty, hunger and malnutrition are eradicated as variables, forces and socio-economic states, that eliminates the possibilities of proper human existence. The capitalism-fed and produced economists have regurgitated their economics of cruelty far too long; not any longer. The world needs no idiosyncratic research to prove whether poverty, hunger and malnutrition are harmful because we need not waste time, energy and effort to conduct research to know whether poison or carbon mono oxide kills or not. because we already know that they do kill. Because it is already established science: it is established science: you keep people in hunger, you make people suffer malnutrition and keep them at poverty and you shall not only destroy their normal and natural health and well-being, their natural growth but, at the same time, you make them ill and you cut not only their life-span but, also, you cut their quality of life: you make them suffer the agony of a life-sentence of unimaginable suffering. Those capitalism-fed economists and theorists and political leaders and pundits, who can not spell poverty, who can really imagine what hunger is or what malnutrition is keep on parroting their dead and rotting theories, that they got into their brain; not any more. Science must not find its voice and the world humanity must not be kept at poverty and given hunger and malnutrition to keep on suffering and keep on dying.

The world can not keep on talking about health while poverty, hunger and malnutrition devastate and maul human existence. There can not be any health and well-being while people are left in poverty, hunger and malnutrition. Therefore, rights to universal healthcare and nutritional and balanced food and drink, must, now become a reality. It is no good to offer 'tube feeds' to the child, that is at the hospital, facing death from hunger and malnutrition. Stop child poverty, stop the child getting devastated by malnutrition and it shall not need to be tube fed at hospitals. Stop the mothers suffering poverty, hunger and malnutrition so that their children do not die, do not suffer the horrors of poverty. These world states and governments and these capitalism-fed, capitalism-grown and capitalism-sustained economists and theorists, can not keep on enforcing poverty, hunger and malnutrition to the vast majority of humanity and keep on running their economics of high-cruelties, high-barbarities and high-brutalities. It is no longer going to be accepted and it is

never going to be acceptable. It is time to accept there is no health, there can not be any unless nutritionally balanced food and drinks are available to all. Humanity needs neither pills nor supplements to get better from illnesses, which they shall not get, if, they are able to eat and drink the nutritionally balanced food and drink their bodies need. The cruelty economics, that denies that, has no right to exist.

The pandemic is estimated to have driven between 119 and 124 million more people into extreme poverty last year. And there is convincing evidence that it has widened gender gaps in employment, with women exiting the labour force in greater numbers than men over the past 12 months. These inequities in people's living conditions, health services and access to power, money and resources are long-standing. The result: under-five mortality rates among children from the poorest households are double that of children from the richest households. Life expectancy for people in countries with low-income is 16 years lower than for people in countries with high-income. For example, nine out of 10 deaths globally from cervical cancer occur in countries with low and middle income.

But as countries continue to fight the pandemic, a unique opportunity emerges to build back better for a fairer, healthier world by implementing existing commitments, resolutions and agreements while, also, making new and bold commitments. "The COVID-19 pandemic has thrived amid the inequalities in our societies and the gaps in our health systems." says Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, WHO Director-General. "It is vital for all governments to invest in strengthening their health services and to remove the barriers, that prevent so many people from using them, so more people have the chance to live healthy lives."

Safe and effective vaccines have been developed and approved at record speed. The challenge now is to ensure that they are available to everyone who needs them. Key here will be additional support to COVAX, the vaccine pillar in the ACT-Accelerator, which hopes to have reached 100 countries and economies in the coming days.

But vaccines alone will not overcome COVID-19. Commodities, such as, medical oxygen and personal protective equipment:PPE, as well as, reliable diagnostic tests and medicines are, also, vital. So are strong mechanisms to fairly distribute all these products within national borders. The ACT-Accelerator aims to establish testing and treatments for hundreds of millions of people in countries with low and middle-income, who would otherwise miss out. But it still requires \$22.1 billion to deliver these vital tools where they are so desperately needed.

At least, half of the world's population still lacks access to essential health services; more than 800 million people spend, at least, 10% of their household income on health care and out of pocket expenses drive almost 100 million people into poverty each year. As countries move forward post-COVID-19, it will be vital to avoid cuts in public spending on health and other social sectors. Such cuts are likely to increase hardship among already disadvantaged groups, weaken health system

performance, increase health risks, add to fiscal pressure in the future and undermine development gains.

Instead, governments should meet WHO's recommended target of spending an additional 01% of GDP on primary health care. Evidence shows that PHC-oriented health systems have consistently produced better health outcomes, enhanced equity, and improved efficiency. Scaling up PHC interventions across countries with low and middle-income could save 60 million lives and increase average life expectancy by 03.7 years by 2030.

Governments must reduce the global shortfall of 18 million health workers, needed to achieve universal health coverage:UHC by 2030. This includes creating at least 10 million additional full-time jobs globally and strengthening gender equality efforts. Women deliver most of the world's health and social care, representing up to 70% of all health and care workers, but they are denied equal opportunities to lead it. Key solutions include equal pay to reduce the gender pay gap and recognizing unpaid health care work by women.

In many countries, the socio-economic impacts of COVID-19, through loss of jobs, increases in poverty, disruptions to education, and threats to nutrition, have exceeded the public health impact of the virus. Some countries have already put in place expanded social protection schemes to mitigate these negative impacts of wider social hardship and started a dialogue on how to continue providing support to the communities and people in the future. But many face challenges in finding the resources for concrete action. It will be vital to ensure that these precious investments have the biggest impact on those in greatest need, and that disadvantaged communities are engaged in planning and implementing programmes.

City leaders have often been powerful champions for improving health, for example, by improving transport systems and water and sanitation facilities. But too often, the lack of basic social services for some communities traps them in a spiral of sickness and insecurity. Access to healthy housing, in safe neighbourhoods, with adequate educational and recreational amenities, is key to achieving health for all.

Meanwhile, 80% of the world's population living in extreme poverty are in rural areas. Today, eight out of 10 people, who lack basic drinking water services live in rural areas, as do seven out of 10 people, who lack basic sanitation services. It will be important to intensify efforts to reach rural communities with health and other basic social services, including, water and sanitation. These communities also urgently need increased economic investment in sustainable livelihoods and better access to digital technologies.


Increasing the availability of timely, high-quality data that is disaggregated by sex, wealth, education, ethnicity, race, gender and place of residence is key to working out where inequities exist, and addressing them. Health inequality monitoring should be an integral part of all national health information systems.

A recent WHO global assessment shows that only 51% of countries have included data disaggregation in their published national health statistics reports. The health status of these diverse groups is often masked when national averages are used. Moreover, it is often those who are made vulnerable, poor or discriminated against, who are the most likely to be missing from the data entirely.

"Now is the time to invest in health as a motor of development." said Dr Tedros. "We do not need to choose between improving public health, building sustainable societies, ensuring food security and adequate nutrition, tacking climate change and having thriving local economies. All these vital outcomes go hand in hand."

| | Political Economics | | EBRD Supports the First Floating 12.9MW Solar Photovoltaic Plant in Albania | |



| | Tuesday: April 06: 2021 | | | α . Albania is making rapid progress with its plans to meet renewable energy targets, with the construction of a 12.9MW floating solar photo-voltaic:PV farm, due to a

€09.1 million loan, provided by the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development:EBRD. The farm will be the first floating solar plant of this size in Albania and the Western Balkans.

The plant will be built on the Vau i Dejës hydropower plant reservoir, which is managed by Korporata Elektroenergjitike Shqiptare:KESH. It represents a breakthrough in innovative green technology, using Albania's rich solar resources while avoiding the use of scarce land. EBRD loan will be provided to a special-purpose vehicle, owned by KESH and established for the purpose of the construction of the project.

Structured as a project finance loan and provided on a commercial basis, EBRD loan is the first such financing by an international financial institution and will contribute to the commercialisation of KESH, one of Albania's biggest state-owned utilities. KESH owns and operates three large hydropower plants with a total capacity of 1,350MW, that account for about 70% of Albania's domestic generation. The new solar PV plant will contribute to making KESH more resilient to climate-induced risks in relation to hydrology and seasonality.

The project, also, aligns with Albania's broader ambition to develop its solar capacity, which has resulted in two successful auctions, supported by EBRD and delivering highly competitive tariffs: the 140MW Karavasta project and the 100 MW Spitalle project.

EBRD has mobilised €315,830 for the project preparation support, including, from the green economy project preparation and implementation framework, financed by the Austrian government:the DRIVE Fund and from the TaiwanBusiness-EBRD Technical Cooperation Fund.

Mr Francesco Corbo, EBRD Regional Head of Energy for the West Balkans, said, "We are delighted to support this ground-breaking project, which is another major step in Albania's successful drive to boost solar capacity and improve its energy mix. The project is remarkable because of its innovative technology, positive environmental impact and commercial logic. It, also, has the potential to be replicated in the broader Western Balkans region, which has many hydropower reservoirs. This is our first opportunity to finance floating solar PV technology and we look forward to many similar projects in the future."

Mr Besjan Kadiu, CEO of KESH, said, "The project is of special importance for KESH. It positions the company as a contributor to Albanian and global initiatives to invest in renewable generation, using innovative photo-voltaic technology, that is compatible with hydropower generation. Although, modest in size, the project holds opportunities not only for the further development of public generation assets on a strong commercial, technical and environmental basis but, also, showcases the know-how, that is required to operate a hybrid hydro-photovoltaic system. This is another great example of the ongoing partnership between the EBRD and KESH."

EBRD is a leading institutional investor in Albania. To date, the Bank has invested more than €01.5 billion in loans in 110 projects in the country.

|| England || Following Lockdown Easing What Are Opening in England From April 12 ||



II Tuesday: April 06: 2021 II $\dot{\alpha}$. Outdoor hospitality will be among those reopening in England next week after the Prime Minister confirmed that the roadmap was on track and planned easements could go ahead. Significant parts of the indoor economy and further outdoor settings will reopen from April 12, after data confirmed the government's four tests for easing COVID restrictions had been met.

However, the Prime Minister continued to urge caution, with no changes to social contact rules and many restrictions still in place. Outdoor gatherings must still be limited to six people or two households and people must not socialise indoors with anyone they do not live with or have not formed a support bubble with. Confirmation Step Two of the roadmap would proceed came after the measures were agreed at a 'COVID O' meeting and discussed on a Cabinet call earlier on Monday.

Before proceeding to this step, the government studied the latest data to assess the impact of the first step, which began when schools reopened on March 08. The assessment was based on four tests: The vaccine deployment programme continues successfully; Evidence shows vaccines are sufficiently effective in reducing hospitalisations and deaths in those vaccinated; Infection rates do

not risk a surge in hospitalisations which would put unsustainable pressure on the NHS and Assessment of the risks is not fundamentally changed by new Variants of Concern.

As set out in the roadmap, around four weeks is required to see the impact in the data of the previous step. The government is committed to provide a further week's notice to businesses, provided through the update from the Prime Minister. From Monday, April 12, additional premises will be able to reopen, with the rules on social contact applying. Indoor settings must only be visited alone or with household groups, with outdoor settings limited to either six people or two households.

This includes non-essential retail; personal care premises such as, hairdressers, beauty and nail salons; and indoor leisure facilities, such as, gyms and spas but not including saunas and steam rooms, which are due to open at Step three. Overnight stays away from home in England will be permitted and self-contained accommodation can, also, reopen, though, must, only, be used by members of the same household or support bubble.

Public buildings, such as, libraries and community centres will, also, reopen. The majority of outdoor settings and attractions can, also, reopen, including, outdoor hospitality, zoos, theme parks, drive-in cinemas and drive-in performances events. Hospitality venues will be able to open for outdoor service, with no requirement for a substantial meal to be served alongside alcohol and no curfew. The requirement to eat and drink while seated will remain.

People should continue to work from home where they can and minimise domestic travel where they can. International holidays are still illegal. The number of care home visitors will increase to two per resident and all children will be able to attend any indoor children's activity, including, sport, regardless of circumstance.

Parent and child groups of up to 15 people not counting children, aged, under five years old, can restart indoors. Funerals can continue with up to 30 attendees. Weddings, outdoor receptions and commemorative events, including, wakes will be able to take place with up to 15 attendees in premises, that are permitted to open.

The government is publishing an update on the four reviews, established in the roadmap to determine what measures may be necessary from summer onwards.

A COVID-status certification system will be developed over the coming months, which could allow higher-risk settings to be opened up more safely and with more participants. Over the coming months, a system will be developed, which will take into account three factors: vaccination, a recent negative test or natural immunity, determined on the basis of a positive test taken in the previous six months.

Events pilots will take place from mid-April to trial the system. All pilots are checking COVID status, initially, this will be through testing alone but in later pilots vaccination and acquired immunity are expected to be alternative ways to demonstrate status.
