|| United Kingdom || The Government Announces Roadmap to Cautiously and Gradually Ease Lockdown in Four Stages: March 08: April 12: May 17: June 21 ||



|| Monday: February 22: 2021 || α. Mr Boris Johnson MP, the UK Prime Minister has set out the roadmap for England at the House of Commons today to, cautiously, ease lockdown restrictions, while other Devolved Nations will follow their own roadmap similar to this one. In his statement to the Parliament this afternoon he paid tribute to the extraordinary success of the UK's vaccination programme and the resolve of the British public in following the lockdown restrictions, which has helped to cut infection rates and reduce the spread of the virus. The Prime Minister said that getting children back into school has been the top priority and so from March 08 all children and students will return to face to face education in schools and college. This shows, at least, the Government

has learnt some lessons. Caution, prudence by reason, science, data and pragmatism must steer the leadership to not just run with it as happened in the past, particularly, last summer, following the first lockdown with the 'eat out to help out'. It is better to go slowly rather than suddenly starting to run and, then faltering and falling down.

The only concern, that should be pointed out, is this: that, despite the fact that the young are not impacted by COVID-19 as badly as the other age groups are, when they get infected, they carry the infection home, which is where the risks reside with regards to opening the schools, which should be opened as soon as possible as everyone understands the vital necessity for children to be at their learning stations. Therefore, the fact that the most at risks groups are already vaccinated is a great advantage but, the Government must focus on the vaccination targets so that it now ought to try and get, say, all the over 40's, including, the remaining other vulnerable groups of people vaccinated as soon as practically possible so that, even, when the children are getting the infection home, the people at home are already vaccinated. This, therefore, must be the highest priority. The staged set-out roadmap reflects the learning, that the Government has undertaken but, it must not be complacent: it must keep its focus and steer the vaccination programmes to accelerate and deliver faster, while we acknowledge and congratulate the NHS in doing a wonderful job so far with the Vaccination programme.

By this point, everyone in the top four vaccine priority cohorts, as determined by the independent JCVI, will have received the first dose of their vaccine and developed the necessary protection from it. Also, from this date: Wraparound childcare and other supervised children's activities can resume where they enable parents to work, seek work, attend education, seek medical care or attend a support group; care home residents will be allowed one regular visitor, provided they are tested and wear PPE. The Stay at Home requirement will remain but, people can leave home for recreation outdoors, such as, a coffee or picnic with their household or support bubble or, with one person outside their household and some university students on practical courses will be able to return to face to face learning.

As part of step one, there will be further limited changes from March 29, the week in which most schools will break up for Easter. Outdoor gatherings of either six people or two households will be allowed, providing greater flexibility for families to see each other. This includes in private gardens. Outdoor sports facilities, such as, tennis and basketball courts, will be allowed to reopen and people can take part in formally organised outdoor sports.

At this point, the Stay at Home order will end, although, many lockdown restrictions will remain. The roadmap, which has now been published on gov.uk, outlines four steps for easing restrictions. Before proceeding to the next step, the Government will examine the data to assess the impact of previous steps. This assessment will be based on four tests: i: The vaccine deployment programme continues successfully; ii: Evidence shows vaccines are sufficiently effective in reducing hospitalisations and deaths in those vaccinated; iii: Infection rates do not risk a surge in

hospitalisations which would put unsustainable pressure on the NHS and iv: the assessment of the risks is not fundamentally changed by new Variants of Concern.

There will be a minimum of five weeks between each step: four weeks for the data to reflect changes in restrictions; followed by seven days' notice of the restrictions to be eased.

Mr Johnson, also, set out the latest vaccine efficacy data, with Public Health England, finding that one dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine reduces hospitalisations and deaths by, at least, 75%. Analysis of the AstraZeneca vaccine efficacy continues, with promising early results. Supported by the increased protection, offered by these vaccines, the Government is able to, slowly and cautiously, begin to ease restrictions in all areas across England at the same time, guided at all stages by data, not dates.

The Chief Medical Officer and the Chief Scientific Adviser have made clear that this will give adequate time to assess the impact of each step and reduce the risk of having to re-impose restrictions at a later date.

People should continue to work from home where possible while overseas travel remains banned, aside for a small number of reasons. The subsequent steps are set out as follows: Step two, no earlier than April 12: Non-essential retail, personal care premises, such as, hairdressers and nail salons and public buildings, such as, libraries and community centres, will reopen.

Most outdoor attractions and settings, including, zoos and theme parks, will, also, reopen; although, wider social contact rules will apply in these settings to prevent indoor mixing between different households. Drive-in cinemas and drive-in performances will, also, be permitted.

Indoor leisure facilities, such as, gyms and swimming pools, will, also, reopen but, only, for use by the people on their own or with their household. Hospitality venues can serve people outdoors only. There will be no need for customers to order a substantial meal with alcohol and no curfew; although, customers must, order, eat and drink while seated.

Self-contained accommodation, such as, holiday lets, where indoor facilities are not shared with other households, can, also, reopen. Funerals can continue with up to 30 people and the numbers able to attend weddings, receptions and commemorative events, such as, wakes will rise to 15 from six.

Step three, no earlier than May 17: Outdoors, most social contact rules will be lifted; although, gatherings of over 30 people will remain illegal. Outdoor performances, such as, outdoor cinemas and outdoor theatres can reopen.. Indoors, the rule of six or two households will apply; although, it will be kept under review whether it is safe to increase this.

Indoor hospitality, entertainment venues, such as, cinemas and soft play areas, the rest of the accommodation sector and indoor adult group sports and exercise classes will, also, reopen. Larger performances and sporting events in indoor venues with a capacity of 1,000 people or half-full,

whichever is lower, will, also, be allowed, as will those in outdoor venues with a capacity of 4,000 people or half-full, whichever is lower.

In the largest outdoor seated venues where crowds can spread out, up to 10,000 people will be able to attend or a quarter-full, whichever is lower. Up to 30 people will be able to attend weddings, receptions and wakes, as well as, funerals. Other life events, that will be permitted, including, bar mitzvahs and christenings.

Step four, no earlier than June 21: It is hoped that all legal limits on social contact can be removed. It is hoped that to reopen nightclubs and lift restrictions on large events and performances, that apply in Step three. This will, also, guide decisions on whether all limits can be removed on weddings and other life events.

In the meantime, the vaccination programme continues at pace, with the announcement of a new target to offer a first dose of the vaccine to every adult by the end of July. The Government hopes that the increased protection, offered by vaccines will, gradually, replace the restrictions, with the roadmap, published today, providing the principles of the transition. MPs will have an opportunity to vote on the regulations at the Parliament, that will enable this roadmap in the coming weeks.

In his statement at the House of Commons, Mr Johnson said, "But no vaccine can ever be 100% effective nor will everyone take them up and like all viruses, COVID-19 will mutate. So, as the modelling released by SAGE today shows, we can not escape the fact that lifting lockdown will result in more cases, more hospitalisations and, sadly, more deaths. This would happen whenever lockdown is lifted, whether now or in six or nine months, because there will always be some vulnerable people, who are not protected by the vaccine. There is, therefore, no credible route to a Zero COVID Britain or, indeed, a Zero COVID World"

"And we can not persist indefinitely with restrictions, that debilitate our economy, our physical and mental well-being and the life-chances of our children. And that is why it is so crucial that this roadmap should be cautious but, also, irreversible. We are setting out on what I hope and believe is a one way road to freedom. And this journey is made possible by the pace of the vaccination programme. In England, everyone in the top four priority groups was successfully offered a vaccine by the middle of February. We now aim to offer a first dose to all those in groups five to nine by April 15 and I am setting another stretching target: to offer a first dose to every adult by the end of July. As more of us are inoculated, so the protection afforded by the vaccines will gradually replace the restrictions." the Prime Minister said.

The Government continues to work closely with the Devolved Administrations as it has done throughout the pandemic. These Devolved Administrations are setting out approaches for easing for Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

|| Asia || The UN Secretary-General to Myanmar's Despotic Generals: No Place For Coups in Today's World: Release the Prisoners: End the Violence: Respect Human Rights and the Will of the People Expressed in Recent Elections ||

On the opening day of a new UN Human Rights Council session on Monday, the UN Secretary-General Mr António Guterres reiterated his full support to the people of Myanmar, three weeks after the military takeover, that has brought thousands out onto the streets in protest. "Coups have no place in our modern world." Mr Guterres said in a pre-recorded video address at the Council's 46th regular session. His comments come after the forum held a special session on February 12, in which it adopted a resolution, expressing deep concern at the junta's move.

“Today, I call on the Myanmar military to stop the repression immediately.” Mr Guterres said. “Release the prisoners. End the violence. Respect human rights and the will of the people, expressed in recent elections. I welcome the resolution of the Human Rights Council, pledge to implement your request and express my full support to the people of Myanmar in their pursuit of democracy, peace, human rights and the rule of law.”

Mr Guterres’ comments followed his censure at the weekend of the use of deadly force in Myanmar, in which a protester, reportedly, 14 years old, was killed in Mandalay, along with one other. Also, addressing the Council at the start of its month-long session, which is being held, almost, entirely remotely to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, Ms Michelle Bachelet, focused on the massive and negative impact of pandemic.

“I think, we all realise that the use of force will not end this pandemic. Sending critics to jail will not end this pandemic. Illegitimate restrictions on public freedoms, the overreach of emergency powers and unnecessary or excessive use of force are not just unhelpful and unprincipled. They deter public participation in decision-making, which is the foundation of sound policy-making.”

In another video message, the President of the UN General Assembly, Mr Volkan Bozkir, underscored the need to focus on people’s basic needs, including, new coronavirus vaccines as the best way to recover from the pandemic. “It is essential that all responses to the COVID-19 pandemic are centred around human rights and promote the protection of our citizens, including, the most vulnerable, who need our care and consideration the most.” he said.

“This includes ensuring the equal and fair distribution of vaccines for all. It is critical that civil society, the private sector and all stakeholders are facilitated to participate and provide feedback throughout the planning and assessment of responses.” Echoing the call for equitable vaccine access in a wide-ranging address, that included a broadside against right-wing extremists becoming a transnational threat and the manipulation of personal digital data by Governments to control citizens’ behaviour, the Secretary-General described the fact that only 10 countries had administered more than 75% of all COVID-19 vaccines as the latest moral outrage.

“Vaccine equity affirms human rights. Bu vaccine nationalism denies it. Vaccines must be a global public good, accessible and affordable for all.” Mr Guterres said. Taking up that theme, Ms Bachelet insisted that the new coronavirus crisis had illustrated the deadly realities of discrimination. Deep inequalities and chronic under-funding for essential services were to blame with policy-makers largely responsible for ignoring these basic needs.

“Today, the medical impact of the pandemic is far from over and its effects on economies, freedoms, societies and people have only just begun. The global rise in extreme poverty, accelerating inequalities; setbacks to women's rights and equality; to education and opportunities for children and young people; and to the Sustainable Development Agenda are shocks that could shake the foundations of societies.” she said.

Despite the scale of the challenges, posed in this second year of the pandemic, the High Commissioner struck a positive note, insisting that the possibility of rebuilding better, more inclusive systems, which address root causes and prepare us to meet the challenges we will certainly face. Among the many major problems, facing the people everywhere, the UN Secretary-General highlighted the disproportionate gender impact of COVID-19.

“The crisis has a woman’s face.” he said. “Most essential frontline workers are women; many from racially and ethnically marginalised groups and at the bottom of the economic ladder. Most of the increased burden of care in the home is taken on by women.” Persons with disabilities, older persons, refugees, migrants and indigenous peoples had, also, paid a higher price than others during the first year of the pandemic. Mr Guterres continued, before calling for a special focus on safeguarding the rights of minority communities, many of whom are under threat around the world.

Cautioning against policies of assimilation, that seek to wipe out the cultural and religious identity of minority communities he said that the diversity of communities was fundamental to humanity. And without identifying any specific countries, Mr Guterres spoke out against the rising and potentially international threat of right-wing extremist movements.

“White supremacy and neo-nazi movements are more than domestic terror threats. They are becoming a transnational threat.” he said. “Far too often, these hate groups are cheered on by people in positions of responsibility in ways, that were considered unimaginable not long ago. We need global co-ordinated action to defeat this grave and growing danger.”

|| The Humanion || Rohingya Refugees: UNHCR Urges Immediate Rescue to Prevent Tragedy on the Andaman Sea ||



|| Monday: February 22: 2021 || á. UNHCR called for immediate efforts to search and rescue a group of Rohingya refugees, who have been adrift on the Andaman Sea for over a week. The precise number and location of the refugees is unknown and there are reports that many may have already lost their lives, Mr Indrika Ratwatte, the Director of the UNHCR Regional Bureau for Asia and the Pacific, based in Bangkok, said in news release. The last information of distress was received on Saturday evening, local time.

“In the absence of precise information as to the refugees’ location, we have alerted the authorities of the relevant maritime states of these reports and appealed for their swift assistance, should the vessel be found in their area of responsibility for search and rescue. Immediate action is needed to save lives and prevent further tragedy.” she said. The refugees are believed to have departed from Cox’s Bazar and Teknaf, southern Baangladesh, about ten days ago and their vessel had been reported to have been adrift after the engine broke down, more than a week ago, according to UNHCR.

Refugees have reported that the vessel has been out of food and water for several days now and that many of the passengers were ill. “Many are in a highly vulnerable condition and are apparently suffering from extreme dehydration. We understand that a number of refugees have already lost their lives and that fatalities have risen over the past 24 hours.” said Mr Ratwatte.

The Andaman Sea is a body of water in the Indian Ocean. It lies to the southeast of the Bay of Baangla, south of Myanmar, west of Thailand and east of India's Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The UNHCR official appealed to all governments to deploy their search and rescue capacities and promptly disembark those in distress, stressing that saving lives must be the priority.

"In line with international obligations under the law of the sea and longstanding maritime traditions, the duty to rescue persons in distress at sea should be upheld, irrespective of nationality or legal status," he urged. "UNHCR stands ready to support governments across the region in providing any necessary humanitarian assistance and quarantine measures in the coming days for those disembarked, in line with public health protocols." Mr Ratwatte said.

"The fact that refugees and migrants continue to undertake fatal journeys accentuates the need for immediate and collective regional response to search, rescue and disembarkation." Several hundred people are reported to have perished trying to cross the Andaman Sea, a journey once dubbed as three times more deadly than in the Mediterranean, due to starvation, dehydration, debilitating diseases, people being thrown overboard alive or denied life-saving care and support.

The complex Rohingya refugee crisis erupted in August 2017, following attacks on remote police outposts in western Myanmar by armed groups, alleged to belong to the community. These were followed by systematic counter attacks against the minority, mainly, Muslim Rohingya, which human rights groups, including, senior UN officials, have said amounted to ethnic cleansing.

In the weeks that followed, over 700,000 Rohingya, the majority of them children, women and the elderly, fled their homes for safety in Baangladesh, with little more than the clothes on their backs. Prior to the mass exodus, well over 200,000 Rohingya refugees were sheltering in Baangladesh as a result of earlier displacements from Myanmar.

|| England || NHS England Gets Full Steam Ahead With the NHS Vaccination Programme As Two-Thirds of 65-69 Year Olds Already Vaccinated: All Adults Population Should Receive Vaccination by the End of July ||



|| Monday: February 22: 2021 || α. Over two thirds of the people, aged between 65 and 69 in England have now had their first COVID vaccination, after invites went out a week ago, with people, aged 64, are, also, set to be called forward this week, NHS England has announced. Anyone, aged 65 to 69, who has not been vaccinated is now being urged to respond to their recent invite to get their life-saving vaccine at one of the more than 100 vaccination centres and, almost, 200 pharmacies across the country.

Those in this age group are now eligible to receive the vaccine, with more than one million invitation letters having arrived in homes across England this week and online bookings open. Anyone, who is 65 or over, can get an appointment in one of the vaccination centres by booking through the national booking service, as the NHS looks to help as many people in this age group get their vaccine and make use of available doses. The fresh call to those, aged 65 to 69, comes as invites for around 460,000 people, aged 64, are due to land on doorsteps later this week, with this group of, nearly, half a million people, set to be asked, initially, to book a slot at one of the larger vaccination centres.

NHS Chief Executive Sir Simon Stevens said, “The NHS COVID vaccination campaign continues full steam ahead; letters, inviting everyone, aged 65 to 69, went out a week ago and, already, over two thirds of them have had their first COVID vaccination. Across England overall nearly a third of adults have now had their first jab and early signs suggest this is contributing to the welcome fall in coronavirus hospitalisation, that we’re now seeing.”

NHS England Medical Director, Professor Stephen Powis, said, “Over 14.5 million of the most vulnerable people in England have already safely had their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and

with people, aged between 65 and 69, now eligible, too, we want everyone else in this age group to consider making this week your week to get a jab.”

The Health and Social Care Secretary Mr Matt Hancock said, “Our vaccination programme is accelerating at unprecedented pace and in England we have now vaccinated over 14 million of those most vulnerable to COVID with their first dose. Every jab brings hope. Each jab means more of our loved ones will soon be protected from this awful virus and is another step forward in returning to normality in the future. I urge everyone who is eligible for the vaccine to come forward as soon as possible so we can beat this pandemic together.”

Vaccines Minister Mr Nadhim Zahawi said, “The NHS is working tirelessly to vaccinate those most at risk as quickly as possible and we are moving through the priority list at rapid pace. The vaccination programme continues to expand and we are calling on everybody who is eligible to book their appointments as soon as possible.”

Larger vaccination centres have been opened nationwide, making use of sports stadiums, racecourses, museums and religious settings as convenient community settings where people can access a vaccine and maintain safe social distancing. High street pharmacists have, also, joined the great mobilisation to protect the country and people in the 65 and over age bracket can get their appointment at a community pharmacy, if, they prefer.

With important progress already made, including, everyone, aged, 70 years old and over, offered a vaccine and all care homes visited for vaccination where it’s safe to do so; NHS England is now seeking to drive uptake among the next priority groups. People, who have received a letter can log on to the national booking service at www.nhs.uk/covid-vaccination and choose from 107 large-scale vaccination centres or 195 pharmacy led sites.

Anyone, unable to book online can call 119 free of charge, anytime between 07:00 and 23:00 seven days a week. Although, having your NHS number to hand will reduce the booking time, knowing it is not required to get a slot for a vaccine, as anyone in the top six priority groups, identified by the JCVI can book their appointment online or by phone.

Should anybody, aged 65 to 69, want to wait to be called by their local GP vaccination service they are still able to do so. The NHS made history in January, following the ground-breaking world-first Pfizer vaccine in December, when Mr Brian Pinker became the first person in the world to receive the Oxford:AstraZeneca vaccine outside of a clinical trial.
