As the French Senate prepares to debate a law, that is said to 'to strengthen respect for the principles of the Republic' today, Amnesty International is calling for the many problematic provisions of the bill to be scrapped or amended. It is always 'the way' powers of all kinds try to venture to attack 'the liberties', that exist in the people, in the guise of 'protecting' 'the Republic', 'the Soviet', 'the Mother Land', 'the Fatherland,' 'the Religion', 'the Values', 'the Reich', 'the This' and 'the That'.

In essence, what is a Republic and what are its values and principles unless that exist in and stand for the values of the very people, that established that Republic? And why powers, that naturally reside in the people need to be 'infringed' and channelled away from the people and given to the Republic? Respect, uphold, strengthen and follow the due process of and the rule of law; that is why the Republic, whether it is the French Republic or the American, exists. It does not require laws to protect itself: it has all it needs and it must get on with and administer and deliver that due process and the rule of law.

It must not use 'idiosyncratic language and rhetoric as despotic and dictatorial states, often, have been found to have done. This very expression, 'to strengthen respect for the principles of the Republic' reminds refined minds and intellects of language and reality of a Kafkaesque nature and future, in which a great chunk of Europe had fallen into and are still struggling to get out of. France must not follow this ruinous path: because this path is the absolute way to go should the Country to try to bury the French Republic, that the French people had founded following their great Revolution, that had added a great achievement to human development and progression.

According to Amnesty International, this proposed legislation would give the French authorities new powers to deny or withdraw funds to certain organisations. Against a backdrop of stigmatising rhetoric about Muslims and Islam, there are serious concerns that the law will be applied in a discriminatory way.

Mr Marco Perolini, Amnesty International's Europe Researcher, said, "This proposed law would be a serious attack on rights and freedoms in France. It would allow public authorities to fund only organisations, which sign a 'contract of republican commitment', a vaguely defined concept, which is wide open to abuse and threatens the very freedoms of expression and association the French authorities claim to stand for."

Several elements of the bill raise concerns, regarding France's obligations to respect the rights to freedom of association and expression and the principle of non-discrimination. Amnesty International calls on France to allocate funds in a non-discriminatory manner and to ensure that all organisations, including, those, that are critical of governmental policies and work on combatting discrimination have the same chances of receiving funding.

In its statement, setting out the justification for the bill, the government mentions the need to strengthen a legal arsenal, that is insufficient to tackle 'radical Islam'. "Time and again we have

seen the French authorities use the vague and ill-defined concept of 'radicalisation' or 'radical Islam' to justify the imposition of measures without valid grounds, which risks leading to discrimination in its application against Muslims and other minority groups. This stigmatisation must end." said Mr Marco Perolini.

# | | Political Economics | | There Is No Future for Fossil Fuels: There Is No Future for Dinosaur Economics: There Is No Way Out for India's Stranded Thermal Power Assets | |

India's 40 gigawatts:GW of stressed and stranded thermal power assets, identified by a special parliamentary committee in March 2018, still linger on, most of them without any feasible resolution. The multitude of fundamental problems still persist despite efforts to resolve them by the government, lending institutions and proponents of the projects. These include lack of appropriate coal linkages, lack of power purchase agreements:PPAs and capital cost over-runs due to delays in acquiring land, accumulated interest funding costs and getting environmental clearances.

For example, some 24.4GW of the total stranded capacity was fully commissioned, however, 08.2GW of it lacked PPAs as per the committee's report. Consecutive years of flattening power demand are extinguishing hopes that a sustained rise in power demand growth, might, partially, revive the stranded capacity without PPAs. Also, availability of ultra-cheap renewables at sub-Rs02.5:kWh compared to coal-fired power tariffs of above Rs04.0:kWh means that renewables are eating into the market share of coal-fired generation and will serve the incremental supply requirements when electricity demand starts growing at the expected rate of 05-06% per annum.

India's total electricity demand grew by only 0.9% in the fiscal year 2019:20 and was further suppressed by the COVID-19 pandemic. Year-to-date demand in 2020:21 is down 02.6% in 2020:21. In FY2019:20 thermal generation, including, gas, dropped by 02.7% compared to FY2018:19, losing market share from 78% of the total generation in FY2018:19 to 75% in FY2019:20. Whereas renewable generation increased 09.1% in FY2019:20 and is up by 02.2% year-to-date in FY2020:21 despite an overall drop in demand due to the pandemic.

The Reserve Bank of India:RBI wants to push the 40GW of non-performing assets to bankruptcy proceedings, if, the proponents and the lenders are unable to resolve the assets outside the National Company Law Tribunal:NCLT. Fully or partially built projects with coal linkages and PPAs have a greater chance of finding resolutions outside NCLT through strategic debt restructuring or recapitalisation from the lenders, albeit, only, after taking significant write-downs. However, most of the stressed projects are still not fully resolved. And some of the projects saw previously interested investors back away in 2020.

JSW Energy recalled its bid for acquiring Ind-Barath thermal power plant, owned by Australian asset manager Macquarie Group, through the insolvency process initiated in 2019, citing the COVID-19 pandemic. The power generation infrastructure developer had agreed to pay Rs845 crore or \$116 million upfront for the under-construction pithead 700MW coal-fired power plant in Odisha.

But JSW Energy leveraged an 'adverse events' clause to pull out from the deal, structured in October 2019, due to the pandemic impacting the viability of the project. IEEFA has looked at some of the non-performing assets for which either a resolution has yet to be agreed or, one has been agreed but not yet executed. These are projects, that are fully commissioned or very near to completion with adequate PPAs and coal linkages. Some of them are pithead plants with levelised tariffs of below Rs04:kWh.

Andhra Pradesh State Power Generation Company was planning to acquire the 01.2GW Athena Chhattisgarh power plant, co-owned by Athena Ventures, PTC India and IDFC, to resolve the stranded asset outside NCLT. However, the Andhra Pradesh State Engineering Board:APSEB in April 2020 wrote to the Andhra Pradesh Energy Secretary to advise against acquiring the asset. APSEB suggested that acquisition of the power plant would be risky, as it still does not have a coal linkage, expensive and techno-commercially unfeasible for the state's grid.

Similarly, Adani Power withdrew its offer to acquire 03.6GW, 01.8GW still under construction, of KSK's Mahanadi Chhattisgarh power plant after the Uttar Pradesh distribution company:discom, one of the major off-takers of the power plant, demanded a Rs0.32:kWh reduction in the agreed tariff. Lanco's 01.2GW Anpara C, Jindal Power's 01.2GW Derang, Jaypee Power's Nigrie and Bina projects have no resolutions yet as there are no interested buyers for the assets.

According to Global Energy Monitor's:GEM data no new Indian coal-fired power plants were announced in the last 12 months. Moreover, there has been no movement in the 29.3GW of preconstruction, announced + pre-permitted + permitted, project pipeline in the last 12 months. This is an indication of the lack of availability of financing for new coal-fired power projects and:or demand for additional power by discoms. The continued financial distress in India's power distribution sector makes thermal PPAs, even, more unbankable absent long-delayed distribution sector reforms.

In September 2020, the Indian government-owned thermal behemoth, NTPC, announced that it would not be pursuing any new greenfield development of coal-fired power projects. Last year the states of Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh announced they would not pursue new coal-fired power project development, as did Gujarat.

With the persisting structural issues in India's coal-fired power sector there is no appetite from international or domestic investors, apart from state-owned Power Finance Corporation:PFC and Rural Electrification Corporation:REC, to risk capital in a sector that continues to carry \$40-60 billion of non-performing assets.

GEM's data shows more than 601GW of coal-fired power projects have been cancelled in the last decade. Year-to-date thermal capacity additions could hit a record low in FY2020:21 with just 01.27GW of net new coal-fired capacity added as of January 2021. There was 0.76GW of end-of-life coal-fired capacity retired against 2.03GW gross new coal-fired capacity additions.

New thermal capacity additions form only 18% of the total capacity added in FY2020:21. On the other hand, variable renewable capacity forms 77% of the total new capacity added with 05.52GW of new capacity additions as of January 2021, 01.4GW of new solar was added in January 2021 alone. Although, renewable capacity installations are nowhere near the targeted annual capacity additions of ~35GW to reach India's ambition of building 450GW of renewables by 2030, the significantly higher share of renewables compared to coal is reflective of the transition that is well underway in India's electricity market.

The recent record low tariffs of Rs01.99:kWh achieved in Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam's:GUVNL 500MW auction and Rs02.00:kWh in Solar Energy Corporation of India's:SECI 01.2GW auction, 16% lower than the previous record low tariff of Rs02.36:kWh just six months earlier, illustrate continued accelerated deflation in India's renewable energy prices.

Against the mounting pressure of fuel cost inflation and high capital costs of emissions control systems, expensive and inefficient coal-fired power plants will have to be retired. Moreover, partially built stressed assets will have to be written down, realising a massive loss for India of public and private capital.

### | | The Humanion | | Finland: Will to Do: What Just One Country Can Do to Support Others Should It Wish to Do So | |



Il Monday: March 29: 2021 Il  $\dot{\alpha}$ . More than 200 million people across the globe need humanitarian assistance due to conflicts, natural disasters and the COVID-19 pandemic. The provision of humanitarian assistance is one of the most concrete ways of responding to crises and disasters. Finland has granted a total of EUR69.6 million to humanitarian work, carried out by the UN organisations, the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement and Finnish civil society organisations.

In its humanitarian action, Finland emphasises the rights of women and girls, disability inclusion and school meals. The majority of the funding now granted by the Country's Ministry for Foreign Affairs will be channelled to UN organisations. Through its core funding, Finland supports food security, EUR08 million to the World Food Programme:WFP; emergency shelters for refugees and their protection and education, EUR07 million to the UN Refugee Agency:UNHCR and EUR05 million to the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees: UNRWA.

Further the co-ordination of humanitarian action, EUR02.5 million to the UN Office for the Co-ordination of Humanitarian Affairs:OCHA. In addition, funding will be used to respond to sudden disasters and underfunded protracted crises, EUR08 million to the UN Central Emergency Response Fund:CERF) and to disaster risk reduction, EUR01 million to the UN Office for Disaster Risk Reduction:UNDRR.

"The coronavirus pandemic has further accentuated the importance of predictable and flexible humanitarian funding. The best way to ensure rapid and timely delivery of assistance in sudden disasters is to decide on funding early in the year." says the Minister for Development Co-operation and Foreign Trade Mr Ville Skinnari.

Finland grants not only core funding but, also, funding for the regional and thematic work, conducted by UN agencies. WFP will use Finland's funding to improve food security in the Sahel and Afghanistan, EUR04 million and to strengthen the food security of persons with disabilities, EUR01 million; UNHCR will support refugees in South Sudan and its neighbouring countries, EUR02 million, Tigray in Ethiopia, EUR02 million and Syria and its neighbouring areas, EUR05 million; and UNFPA will improve the reproductive health services for women and girls in Syria, EUR02 million.

The International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement is an important humanitarian partner for Finland. The EUR13 million now granted to it will be distributed between core funding, EUR03 million to the International Committee of the Red Cross:ICRC and thematic programmes as follows: ICRC's emergency assistance to Yemen, EUR02.7 million, South Sudan, EUR02 million, Burkina Faso, EUR01.2 million, Afghanistan, EUR01 million and Ukraine, EUR 0.8 million, as well as, work by the Red Crescent in Syria, EUR01.1 million. These programmes will strengthen the protection, health services, food security and water supply of the most vulnerable people.

EUR10.2 million is granted to humanitarian work by Finnish civil society organisations. The projects will be implemented by Fida International, Finn Church Aid, Finnish Refugee Council, Save the Children Finland, Plan International Finland, Finnish Red Cross and World Vision Finland.

Civil society organisations' projects support, for example, water supply and sanitation, the education of persons with disabilities, as well as, child protection, food security and safe reopening of schools. Civil society organisations have an important role in supporting local humanitarian actors and strengthening their capacity to respond to crises. Besides several African countries, this year the projects of Finnish civil society organisations will be supported in Yemen, Myanmar and North Korea as well.


Additionally, Finland funds the EU's humanitarian assistance through its contribution to the EU budget. The European Union, together with its Member States, is the world's largest donor of humanitarian assistance.

### | | England | | 25 Million Have Been Vaccinated While 02.5 Million Have Received Their Second Dose | |



II Monday: March 29: 2021 II  $\dot{\alpha}$ . NHS England has vaccinated more than 25 million people against COVID-19, with the number of people receiving their second dose reaching a new weekly high. Over 02.5 million people have now received their second dose, with more than one in three of those, taking place just in the last week, when more than 900,000 returned to get their next dose, around twice as many as did so the week before.

Focus is now on to make sure that absolutely everyone in the most at-risk cohorts has had the chance to be vaccinated, ahead of the target of offering all priority groups their first vaccine by April 15 and when there is tighter supply of available doses next month. The Country's senior GP is urging those, aged, 50-69, who are yet to get their first dose of the vaccine, to come forward. Three in four 50-54 year olds have now already been vaccinated, up from half in the last week.

Dr Nikki Kanani, a GP and NHS Medical Director for Primary Care, said: "The NHS in England has now vaccinated 25 million people which is an unbelievable achievement by NHS staff across the country, who have continued to work at speed. At the same time as increasing second doses week on week, the NHS is reaching out to those, 50-69 year-olds, who haven't yet taken up the offer to be vaccinated.


If, you are one of those people yet to book a first dose, please come forward and get your life-saving COVID-19 vaccine which will not only protect you but those around you."

People are being urged not to forget about having their second dose of the vaccine too, so they can receive as much protection as possible. Salisbury Cathedral is one of over 1,500 vaccination centres across the country administering vaccination, with people able to listen to a specially arranged cathedral organ recital as they get their jab.

The NHS has been inviting those, eligible for a vaccine by letter and text with GPs, also, calling some patients. Text invitations appear as an alert from 'NHSvaccine' and letters include a web link to click and reserve an appointment at one of more than 300 large-scale vaccination centres or pharmacies across England. GP teams will continue contacting eligible patients and vaccinating them throughout April with a first dose.

### || Elsinki || The Museum for Architecture and Design: Etelaranta: Helsinki: Finland ||



Honday: March 29: 2021 H lpha. Finland's plan to build a new museum for architecture and design has taken an important step as the Country's Ministry of Education and Culture, along with the City of Helsinki, have established a new project organisation to co-ordinate the planning of the new museum. Ms Kaarina Gould, the former Programme Director of Helsinki's World Design Capital year in 2012, who is the current Executive Director of the Finnish Cultural Institute in New York, has been appointed to lead the project.

A high-level steering group has been formed to supervise the project, with Mr Timo Laitinen, the Director General of Finland's State Treasury, as the Chair. The new museum of architecture and design is planned to be constructed in Etelaranta or the South Harbour of Helsinki as part of the overall development of the district. The new museum will merge two existing museums, the Museum of Finnish Architecture and the Design Museum and function as the national museum in these fields.

Once established, the museum of architecture and design will be housed in a new building, constructed in its designated place and become part of the overall development of the district. An architecture competition for the museum is planned for a later stage of the project. The decision to

move ahead with the new museum is based on in-depth surveys and an initial concept plan drawn up in 2018–2019 by the Ministry of Education and Culture, the City of Helsinki, and the two museums.

During the preliminary planning phase, a management and funding model for the museum was also formed. In 2021, a foundation will be established for the new architecture and design museum to manage the present museums' collections. Museum operations will be co-ordinated by a limited liability company, to be established later, which will be fully owned by the foundation. The state of Finland and the City of Helsinki are expected to provide equal shares of capital to the museum foundation. In its fourth supplementary budget proposal for 2020, the Government undertook to capitalise the new museum foundation with a maximum of EUR60 million.

"The revival of cultural activities along with sustainable growth provide a path towards a brighter future. Architecture and design are our strengths and they play an important part in providing sustainable solutions for society. The new museum brings together unique content, competence and creativity. We are working towards a world-class architecture and design museum with a concept that fosters new experiences and insight." says Ms Anita Lehikoinen, the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Education and Culture.

"Global competition between cities will increase notably. As a result of the COVID crisis, the prerequisites for a good life, as well as, human and social capital will play an important role alongside more traditional attractions. In the era we live in, the courage to dream big and invest in the future is needed for nations to succeed. Meanwhile, design and architecture play an increasingly crucial role in solving global problems. There could hardly be a more opportune time to establish a new museum for architecture and design." says Mr Jan Vapaavuori, the Mayor of Helsinki.

"This new stage on the path to the realisation of the New Architecture and Design Museum has been prepared with great care. We are happy to start working with the project organization, as we now move forward with the outlines for the operating principles, core contents and guidelines for the new building and museum. Architecture and design are Finnish strengths, which have helped in realising the values of the Nordic welfare model. The new museum can lead the way and encourage us to discuss, learn and experience different ways of building a new model of the future welfare state," say museum directors, Ms Carina Jaatinen, Museum of Finnish Architecture and Mr Jukka Savolainen, Design Museum.

The next stage is to produce a comprehensive plan, that will allow the funders to make final decisions on the implementation of the project. This phase of the project, led by the newly appointed Project Director Mr Kaarina Gould, will launch on May 01 and is expected to last until late 2023. Gould, experienced with large scale international projects and initiatives such as the World Design Capital Helsinki 2012, will work alongside the teams of the two museums, the organizations of the City of Helsinki and the Ministry of Education and Culture to secure the foundations for building a pioneering museum of international calibre.

"Sustainability and pioneering thinking are the key values that the new museum, both as a concept and a new building, will be built upon. Audiences, architecture and design communities in Finland and the world, have been awaiting this museum for decades. Now the time is right. The past year can be seen as a catalyst for the work that lies ahead, the challenges the pandemic has put on cultural institutions form an obligation and an opportunity to reinvent the museum." says Ms Kaarina Gould.

Supporting and supervising the project will be a steering group, chaired by Mr Timo Laitinen, the Director General of Finland's State Treasury. Other members include leadership from the City of Helsinki, Ministry of Education and Culture, Ministry of Finance, directors and chairpersons of Museum of Finnish Architecture and the Design Museum, and a number of experts from fields of design, finance and urban development.


