This Way by Baming Them They Can Make Them Disappear Altogether So to Ensure That They Are Not Even Here So the Question of Racism Does Not Even Arise: By the Way, Please, Do Mark and Notify the Oxford English Dictionary That Here Is a New English Verb For Them: This New English Verb: To Bame Means To Vanish Or Replace Reality With Fake Or To Deny Reality Or To Whitewash Something to Make the Truth Disappear: And To Include a New Euphemism: People of Colour to Mean You Do Not Want to Hear What I Would Like to Call You Which I Can Not Call You. This is what we have had to write while presenting a TUC commentary about the recent BAME LOT and People of Colour saga in the UK, where, absolutely, categorically, of course, there does not exist any racism of whatsoever colour, shape, size, quantity, quality, appearance, shadow, texture or literally, figuratively, really or virtually: none whatsoever: here in the UK where old buildings, still, hold history, such as, NOT FOR BLACKS DOGS and IRISH in graffiti, a Sociology Lesson of History or KILL PAKIS!, Niggers Go BACK to the SHITHOLE you Came from. But, of course, racism does not exist in the UK. There is now a Report to prove it! And, here we are with the TUC commentary. Commenting on a Report, published on Wednesday, by the Commission on Race and Ethnic Disparities, TUC General Secretary Ms Frances O'Grady said, "Institutional and structural racism exists in the UK, in both the labour market and wider society. Black and Minority Ethnic workers are far more likely than White workers to be in low-paid, insecure jobs, such as, temporary and agency jobs or zero hours contracts. And Black and Minority Ethnic workers have been far more likely to be exposed to COVID infection and far more likely to die because they are far more likely to be in frontline roles.

This is institutional racism. And it traps too many Black and Minority Ethnic workers in poverty, insecurity and low pay. We hoped that the Commission would recommend action to stamp out insecure work and make employers act to close their ethnicity pay gaps. Instead, the Commission has chosen to deny the experiences of Black and Minority Ethnic workers and be complacent about the UK's progress towards being an anti-racist society."

"The TUC calls on politicians of all parties to stand with Black and Minority Ethnic workers and commit to ending institutional racism in the UK labour market and society, starting with bringing in mandatory ethnicity pay gap action plans and banning zero hours contracts."

The TUC has launched an anti-racism task force, chaired by NASUWT General Secretary Dr Patrick Roach, to tackle the structural racism with the labour market and wider society. The task force will lead the trade union movement's renewed campaign against racism at work. It will engage with Black workers across the UK to hear about their experiences. And it will produce recommendations on tackling structural racism in the UK, in workplaces and in unions themselves. Evidence of institutional racism in the UK labour market: One in six, 16% Black, Asian and Minority workers are employed on insecure terms and conditions, compared to one in 10, 10%, white workers.

Male Black, Asian and Minority workers 57% more likely to be employed in jobs with a higher male mortality rate than white male workers. And female of Ethnic Minority workers 48% more likely than female white workers to be employed in an occupation with a higher female mortality rate.

Previous TUC analysis showed that BME people are far more likely to be in jobs with higher coronavirus mortality rates than white people, such as, security guards, carers, nurses and drivers: tuc.org.uk/news/bme-workers-have-been-asked-shoulder-more-risk-during-pandemic-says-tuc

In England, based on a statistical model adjusting for age and excluding care home residents, the rate of death among Black African males was 03.8 times higher than those of White background,

while for Black African females the rate was 02.9 times higher; all ethnic groups other than Chinese females were at higher risk of COVID-19 mortality than the White ethnic population:ONS

|| Global Warming and Climate Change || World’s Energy and Climate Leaders Pledge Clean Energy Action at the IEA-COP26 Net Zero Summit ||



|| Wednesday: March 31: 2021 || α. Senior international energy and climate leaders from more than 40 countries took part in the International Energy Agency COP26 Net Zero Summit today to identify how to work together to reduce global green-house gas emissions and meet the goals of the Paris Agreement. “It is time for the world to move from a decade of climate change deliberation

to a decade of delivery. The UK strongly encourages countries to endorse the IEA's seven principles for achieving net zero.

Today's Summit clearly showed willingness from governments, civil society and businesses to work together in each emitting sector to make this happen and keep the 01.5 degree target within reach." said Mr Alok Sharma, the COP26 President. "This should not be viewed as a shouldering of a burden but, more a sharing of an opportunity. By working together, we can accelerate progress, create jobs and prosperity and protect our planet for future generations."

The Net Zero Summit, co-hosted by IEA Executive Director Dr Fatih Birol and COP26 President Mr Alok Sharma, United Kingdom Government, brought together high-level representatives of energy and climate ministries from countries, including, Australia, Brazil, China, Colombia, the European Union, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, South Africa, the United Kingdom and many others. Participants from a broad cross-section of civil society groups, private companies and government institutions, also, took part in the discussions.

The Summit is a critical milestone on the road to COP26, taking place in Glasgow in November this year. It brought together representatives of countries covering more than 80% of global GDP, population and emissions. Key participants included Mr Zhang Jianhua, China's Minister of Energy, Mr Frans Timmermans, the Executive Vice-President of the European Commission, Raj Kumar Singh, India's Minister of Power, New and Renewable Energy, Mr John Kerry, US Presidential Special Envoy for Climate, Mr Amani Abou-Zeid, African Union Commissioner for Infrastructure and Energy and Ms Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala, the Director-General of the World Trade Organisation.

"Our Net Zero Summit made clear that the vast majority of the world agrees on the gravity of the climate crisis and the urgency of immediate actions to put global emissions on track towards net zero. But it, also, underscored the need for greater international collaboration to drive the rapid global deployment of clean technologies across all the key sectors of the economy." said Dr Fatih Birol, the IEA Executive Director. "No country can do this alone. If, we want the transition to clean energy to happen quickly, the world's major economies have to work much more effectively and closely together. The Summit's Key Principles show what needs to happen and I offer the IEA's full support for the UK COP26 Presidency's efforts to strengthen the international co-operation mechanisms, that will accelerate our transition to net zero."

Many IEA member governments supported the Seven Key Principles presented by the IEA at the Summit to guide the implementation of net zero commitments. The principles cover essential areas, such as, the need for sustainable recoveries from the COVID-19 crisis, the critical importance of implementable emissions reduction roadmaps for the current decade and the development of stronger mechanisms for international co-ordination to accelerate innovation and deployment in each major emitting sector of the global economy. The principles, also, address issues, such as,

technology collaboration, best-practice sharing, investment tracking, ensuring people-centred transitions and integrating energy security and affordability into net zero plans.

To support stronger government actions, the IEA will publish on May 18 the first comprehensive roadmap for the global energy sector to reach net-zero emissions by 2050. Requested by the COP26 Presidency as a key input, the roadmap will set out a pathway for what is needed from governments, companies, investors and citizens to put global emissions on a path in line with a temperature rise of 01.5 degrees. The roadmap will help decision makers to prioritise urgent action in the lead-up to Glasgow.

Also, taking place today was the Climate and Development Ministerial, hosted by COP26 President Mr Sharma and UK Foreign Secretary Mr Dominic Raab, which focussed on countries, that are most vulnerable to the impacts of climate change and helping them set the international agenda in the run-up to COP26 in November. The global gathering brought together countries and partners to build consensus and practical solutions on key issues, such as, responding to climate impacts, fiscal space and debt and climate finance.

|| Ecology || Plastic Pollution Is Disproportionately Hitting Marginalised Groups: New UN Report ||



|| Wednesday: March 31: 2021 || α. Vulnerable communities disproportionately bear the brunt of environmental degradation, caused by plastics pollution and action is urgently needed to address the issue and restore access to human rights, health and well-being, according to a new UN Report,

published yesterday. The Report, entitled, Neglected: Environmental Justice Impacts of Plastic Pollution, was produced by the UN Environment Programme:UNEP, together with the grassroots environmental group, Azul.

The Report findings aim to empower communities, affected by plastic waste and advocate for their inclusion in local decision making. “Environmental justice means educating those on the frontlines of plastic pollution about its risks, including them in decisions about its production, use and disposal, and ensuring their access to a credible judicial system.” said Ms Inger Andersen, UNEP Executive Director. The Report showcases how environmental injustices are linked to plastic production, in areas, such as, deforestation for road building, the displacement of indigenous peoples to conduct oil drilling, as well as, contamination of potable water by fracking operations to extract natural gas, in countries, such as, the United States and Sudan.

Moreover, the Report warns of health problems among African-American communities, living near oil refineries in the Gulf of Mexico and the occupational risks, faced by some two million waste pickers in India. The impacts of plastics on marginalised populations are severe and exist at all stages of the production cycle, from extracting raw materials and manufacturing, through to consumption and disposal, according to the Report.

Plastic waste not only endangers the livelihoods of those, relying on marine resources, it, also, causes a raft of health issues for people, who consume sea-food infested with toxic micro and nano plastics. Women, in particular, suffer from plastic-related toxicity risk, due to higher aggregate exposure to plastics at home and, even, in feminine care products.

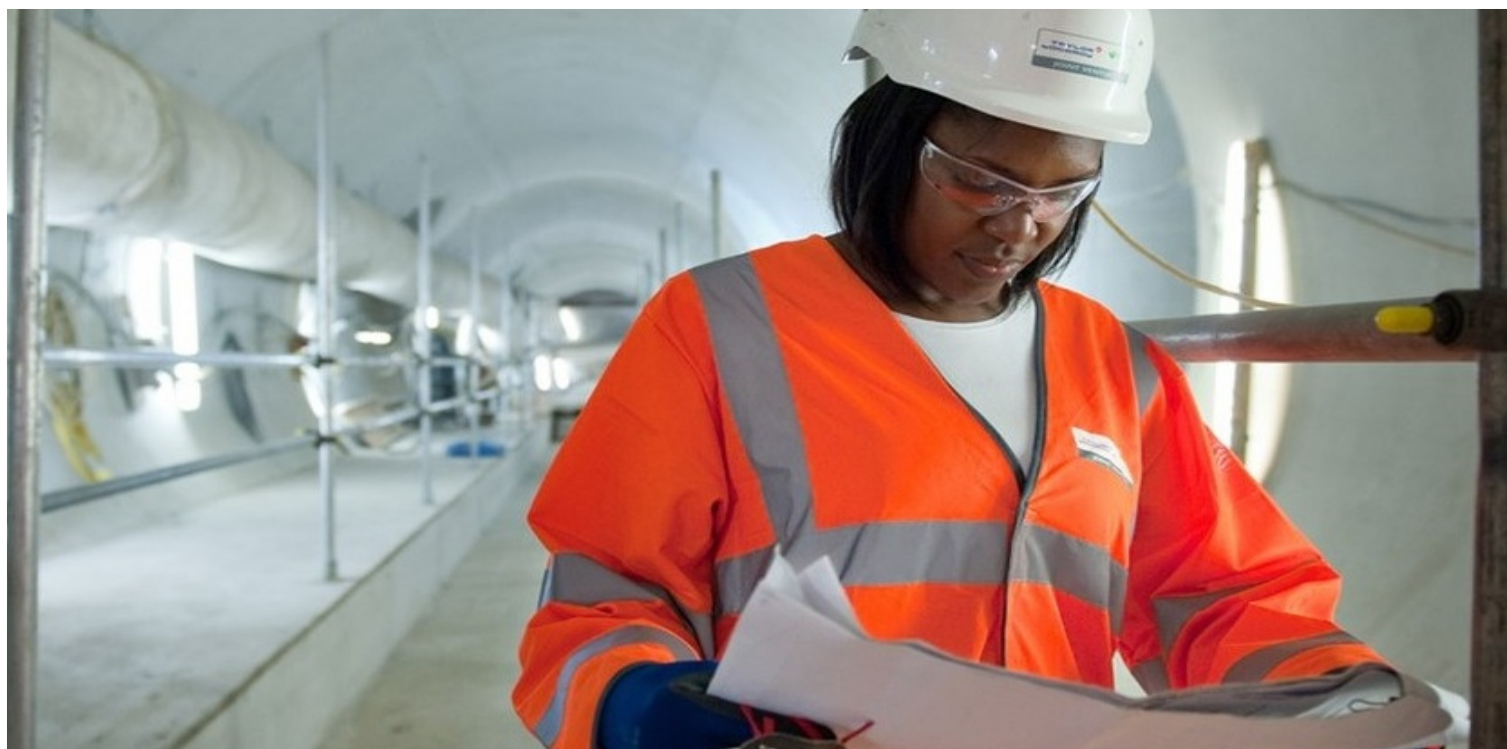
Differences in gender, social roles and political power in regulating plastic use and health standards place women at high risk of miscarriages and cancer, further exacerbating gender-related disparities overall. Aggravated by the COVID-19 pandemic, plastic waste has become a major part of the global pollution crisis, along with bio-diversity loss and climate change, representing a triple emergency, that must be tackled by strong and effective action plans.

The Report calls for governments to prioritise the needs of those, disproportionately affected by plastic pollution, underscoring that action must be taken at multiple levels. It calls for an expansion in plastic waste monitoring, better studies into its health impacts and more investment in waste management. Governments should further enforce bans on single-use plastics and encourage their reduction, recycling and reuse.

Other actors, such as, business and industry leaders, non-governmental actors and consumers should, also, make efforts to reverse the situations for those, who are socially, economically, politically marginalised.

|| The World || COVID-19 Pandemic Ravages Brazil ||



|| Wednesday: March 31: 2021 || α. Brazil's President Mr Jair Bolsonaro went on national TV last week and claimed to have adopted all necessary measures to contain the COVID-19 pandemic. As he was speaking, thousands of Brazilians banged pots on their windows in disagreement; with good reason. Brazil's national health system is on the verge of collapse: Intensive care units across the country are at or near capacity: 24 states have an intensive care unit occupancy rate of over 80%, in 19 states it is 90% or more and in six states it exceeds 100%. News organisations report that people are dying while waiting for a bed.

About a quarter of all COVID-19 deaths in the world last week were in Brazil. And the country broke another record on March 26: more than 3,600 deaths in a 24-hour period. One study estimates that the country may reach 5,000 deaths a day between April and May. Since COVID-19 was declared a pandemic, the President has downplayed the threat, joined crowded events and vetoed a law, that made it mandatory to use masks in schools, stores and prisons. He, even, tried to get the Supreme Court to stop governors and mayors from imposing social distancing rules.

Instead of encouraging the use of masks and social distancing, as recommended by the World Health Organisation:WHO, Brazil's government invested heavily in drugs, that it claimed, without scientific evidence, prevented or cured COVID-19. Add to that the emergence of a new, more contagious variant of the virus and low vaccine availability, only, 07% of Brazilians have received a first dose and it is easy to understand why the country is in such a dire situation.

International human rights law guarantees everyone the right to the highest attainable standard of health and obligates governments to take steps to prevent threats to public health and to ensure access to health care for those who need it.

Without meaningful collaboration among all authorities, including, all governors and without adherence to WHO recommendations, thousands more Brazilian families are likely to lose loved ones. Mr Bolsonaro needs to start listening to science and putting the lives of Brazilians first.

|| Europe || What Is Happening Inside the European Union: Is Poland Not in It: Escalating Threats to Women Activists ||

Bomb and death threats, targeting, at least, seven groups in Poland for supporting women's rights and the right to abortion are disturbing reminders of escalating risks to women's human rights' defenders in the country, Human Rights Watch, CIVICUS and International Planned Parenthood Federation-European Network:IPPF-EN said today. The Polish authorities should urgently investigate, protect the women targeted and hold those responsible for the threats accountable. They should, also, counter abusive misinformation campaigns targeting activists.

Human Rights Watch, IPPF-EN and CIVICUS collected information between March 15 and March 26 from seven organisations in Poland, that have been threatened due to their work for or perceived support of women's rights issues, including, Abortion Dream Team, Federation for Women and Family Planning:Federa, Feminoteka, FundacjaFOR, Helsinki Foundation for Human Rights, Women's Rights Centre:Centrum Praw Kobiet and All-Poland Women's Strike:Ogólnopolski Strajk Kobiet.

"The increasingly hostile and, even, violent environment for women's rights and their defenders in Poland should ring alarm bells for Polish authorities and European Union leaders." said Ms Hillary Margolis, the Senior Women's Rights Researcher at Human Rights Watch. "Women's rights defenders should be able to express themselves publicly, including, when they oppose government policy, without having targets on their backs."

At least, six human rights organisations in Warsaw, including, the women's rights groups Feminoteka, Women's Rights Centre and Women's Strike, received bomb threats via email on International Women's Day, March 08, 2021. The threats said that they were 'payback' for supporting the Women's Strike movement, which has been at the forefront of mass protests, following increased restrictions on access to legal abortion. Some organisations received the threat at multiple email addresses.

Federa, a reproductive rights group, received bomb threats via email on March 12 and March 23. Members of the Women's Strike and the Consultative Council:Rada Konsultacyjna, an independent body of groups, established to develop legal and policy measures to address Women's Strike protesters' demands, received further bomb threats via email on March 20 and March 23. The March 20 threats targeted a performance on that day by an artistic collective in central Warsaw at Szklany Dom:Glass House, near the residence of Deputy Prime Minister and leader of the ruling Law and Justice party: Prawo i Sprawiedliwość, PiS, Mr Jarosław Kaczyński. The performance proceeded following checks of the building by police.

Warsaw city council member Ms Dorota Łoboda, a member of the opposition Civic Coalition and active supporter of women's rights and the Women's Strike movement, also, received bomb and death threats. The district prosecutor's office is reportedly pursuing an investigation into threats against Ms Łoboda.

Staff members at Feminoteka, Federa, Women's Rights Centre, Women's Strike, FundacjaFOR, Helsinki Foundation for Human Rights and Grupa Stonewall reported bomb threats received between March 08 and March 23 to police, who checked the premises of their offices and found no evidence of explosive devices. However, some said that the police minimised the security risks and made no commitment to open and pursue a full investigation. Only, one person, who had reported threats had been told by the police after she inquired that they sent the file to the prosecutor but, she received no information about whether the prosecutor would pursue the investigation.

These escalating threats come amid on-going public protests, led by the Women's Strike movement following an October 2020 ruling by Poland's politically compromised Constitutional Tribunal, that, virtually, eliminates access to legal abortion. The ruling officially took effect after publication in the national Journal of Laws in January.

Activists said that their sense of insecurity is heightened by government rhetoric and media campaigns aiming to discredit them and their work, which foster misinformation and hate, that can put their safety at risk. "I feel like I am not safe here and that they the government make choices about who deserves protection and respect." said a Federa staff member. "For me this is very serious, because it is not just some freaks, who send us a message, saying, 'you are a murderer.' It is in the whole context of what is going on in Poland, where what we are doing is really perceived as something evil."

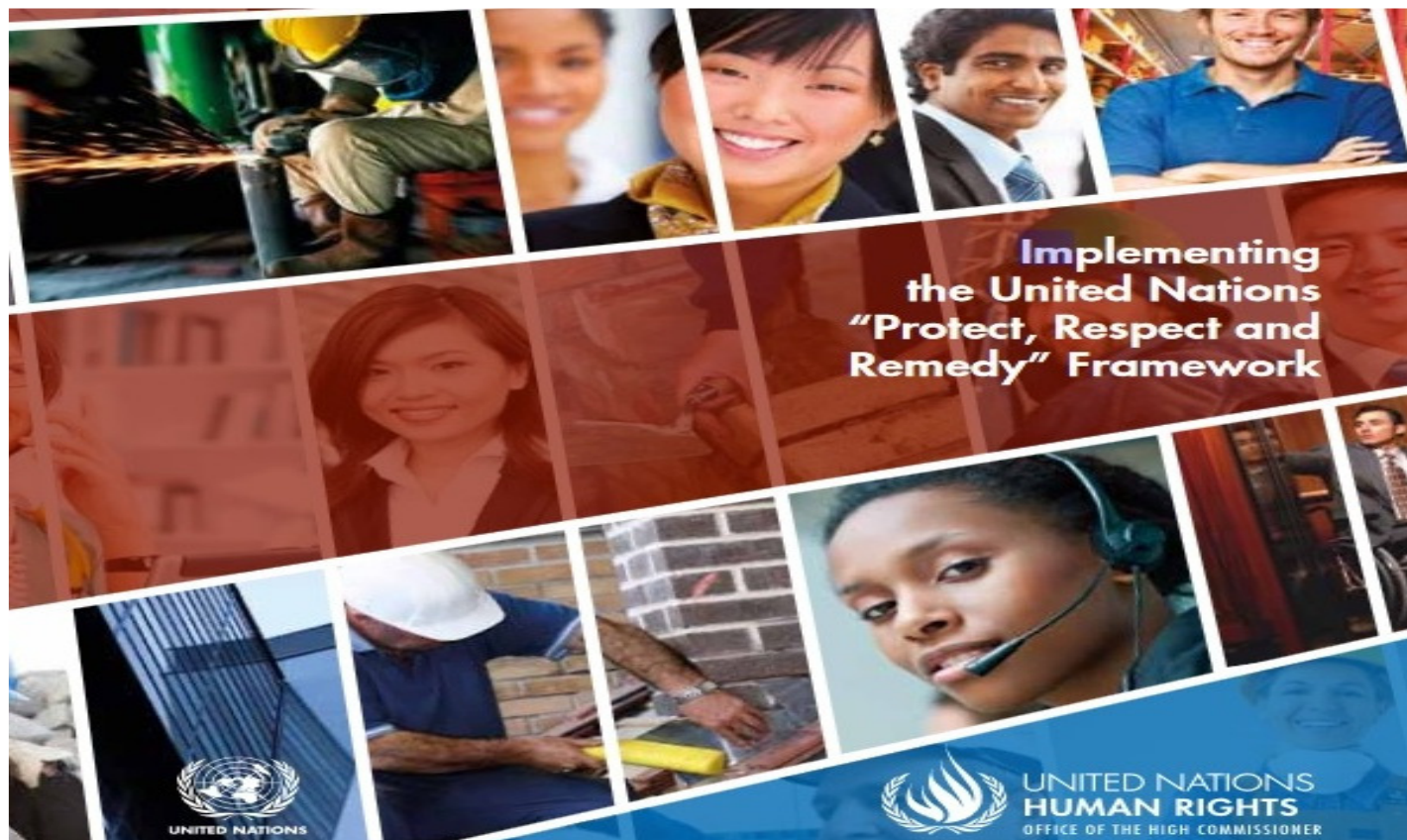
Several women's rights defenders have been detained or face what they claim are politically motivated criminal charges, including, for allegedly praising vandalism of churches, obstructing religious services and creating an 'epidemiological threat' for protests held during the COVID-19 pandemic.

"Instead of stoking anger against those trying to uphold basic rights, Polish officials should focus on doing everything in their power to protect women and women's rights, including, the rights to peaceful assembly and free expression, to access safe and legal abortion and to be protected from violence." said Ms Aarti Narsee, Civic Space researcher at CIVICUS.

Police should thoroughly investigate threats of violence against women's rights and other human rights defenders and punish those responsible, the organisations said. They should work with those targeted to put in place security measures to ensure women's rights defenders can continue their work without fear of violence or reprisals. Prosecutors should drop any politically motivated and baseless charges against activists. Officials should counter public campaigns aimed at spreading misinformation about and generating hatred toward women's and human rights groups.

|| Jurisprudence || Mexico: The Mexican Authorities Must Ensure Justice and Reparations for Victoria Salazar's Death at the Hands of the Police: Amnesty International ||

The Mexican authorities must ensure the protection of Victoria Esperanza Salazar's two daughters and inform her family of the whereabouts of her eldest daughter, who remained unaccounted for at the time this press release was published, said Amnesty International, the Institute for Women in Migration:IMUMI and the Independent Monitoring Group of El Salvador:GMIES on March 29.

They, must, also, guarantee the family's rights to truth, justice, full reparation for damages and the dignified repatriation of her body, the organisations said, following the publication of a video, showing how four police officers caused Victoria's death through use of excessive force in Tulum on March 27. "They held my daughter down too forcefully. They tortured her, to put it bluntly. You can hear her screaming. I think her final screams came when they snapped her neck and broke several of her ribs. I believe that no human being deserves to die like this." Victoria's mother Ms Rosibel Emérita Arriaza told Amnesty International.

"As a mother I know I won't get my daughter back, I'll only be left with the memories I have of her. All I ask for is genuine justice, for them to investigate exactly what happened in this abuse of authority by these four people... that they face the full weight of the law. The Mexican state, must, also, take responsibility as a state, because this was a similar case to what happened in the United States with George Floyd."

The Mexican Commission for Refugee Assistance:COMAR publicly confirmed that Victoria Salazar had been in Mexico as a refugee since 2018. Ms Rosibel confirmed that on the afternoon of Monday, March 29, she learned of the location of Victoria's youngest daughter, who is 15 years old, but did not know the status or location of her eldest daughter, who is 16. She said that no Mexican authority had contacted her and that she only found out about the killing of her daughter from someone, who saw it on the news.

The Quintana Roo Human Rights Commission told Amnesty International that it had no information on the whereabouts of the elder daughter and that she was not in the custody of the National System for Integral Family Development. It is extremely concerning that the Mexican authorities have not informed Victoria's family about the whereabouts of her two daughters. The organisations behind this press release call on the Mexican authorities to make contact with Victoria Salazar's family to clarify the whereabouts of both girls and guarantee their safety.

They, must, also, take all necessary measures to ensure the dignified repatriation of Victoria's body to El Salvador, including, granting visas to her family and covering their travel and other related expenses. As Amnesty International stated in the report Mexico: The (r)age of women: Stigma and violence against women protesters, published in early March, the authorities should establish an on-going monitoring and oversight mechanism to measure and evaluate the effectiveness of existing use of force policies, protocols and guidelines.

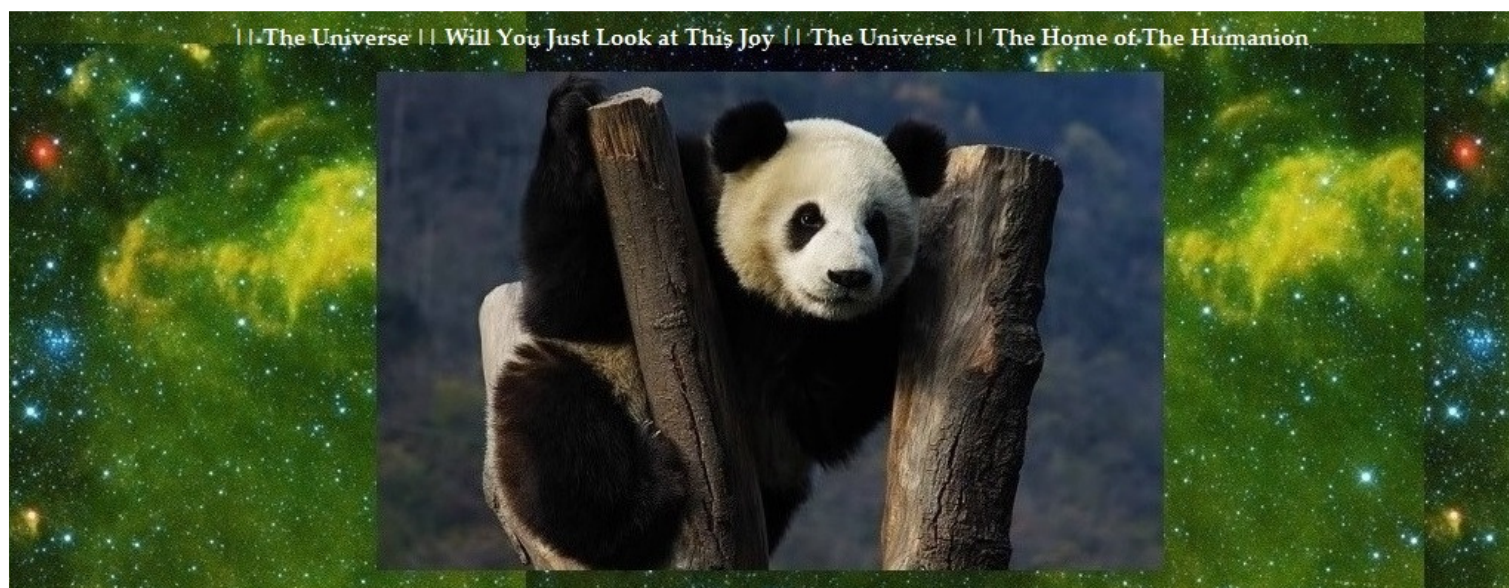
In investigations into unnecessary and excessive use of force, they should establish not only the responsibility of individual police officers, but, also, the possible responsibility of members of the chain of command. The authorities should constantly train police forces in human rights, including, women's rights and consciousness of gender-based violence, with theoretical and practical tools in accordance with international best practices.

They should carry out constant and exhaustive evaluations of police training, as well as, evidence of its results and impact and guarantee the existence of a specialised, external and independent mechanism in charge of monitoring, supervising and improving these institutions.

"We consider it unacceptable that police abuses, such as, Victoria's femicide continue to occur in Mexico. The authorities must strengthen the police forces with specialised training in the appropriate use of force to prevent grave human rights violations from being committed by those, who should be protecting us." the organisations said.

|| Asia || Indonesia: UN Special Rapporteurs Denounce Mega Tourism Project That Tramples on Human Rights ||



|| Wednesday: March 31: 2021 || α. A group of UN Special Rapporteurs raised alarm over forced evictions of locals and indigenous peoples and threats against human rights defenders, to make way for a \$03 billion tourism project on the Indonesian island of Lombok. “Credible sources have found that the local residents were subjected to threats and intimidations and forcibly evicted from their land without compensation. Despite these findings, the ITDC has not sought to pay compensation or settle the land disputes.”

In a joint statement, led by Mr Olivier De Schutter, UN Special Rapporteur on extreme poverty and human rights, they highlighted the expulsions of local communities and destruction of houses, fields, water sources, cultural and religious sites, as the Indonesian Government and the country's Tourism Development Corporation:ITDC 'groomed Mandalika to become a 'New Bali'.

“The Government's aim is to create an enormous tourism complex in Mandalika, which is situated in Lombok's impoverished West Nusa Tenggara Province, with a Grand Prix motorcycle circuit, parks, resorts and hotels.” the Rapporteurs said. To date, the project has attracted more than \$01 billion in private investment and is being managed by Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank:AIIB, a multi-lateral financial institution.

They criticised a lack of due diligence by the AIIB and private businesses to identify, prevent, mitigate and account for how they address adverse human rights impacts, as set forth in the UN Guiding Principles on business and human rights. “In light of the dark history of human rights violations and land grabs in the region, the AIIB and businesses can not look the other way and carry on business as usual.” they said.

“Their failure to prevent and address risks of human rights abuses is tantamount to being complicit in such abuses.” the statement said. In March 2021, several UN experts voiced their concerns in

joint communications to the Indonesian Government, the ITDC and the AIIB, as well as, to concerned private companies, involved in the project, as well as, their home States, France, Spain and the United States, the statement noted.

Special Rapporteur Mr De Schutter highlighted that the Mandalika project puts Indonesia's laudable commitments to the Sustainable Development Goals:SDGs and its underlying human rights obligations to the test. He added that large-scale tourism development, that 'tramples on human rights is fundamentally incompatible' with the concept of sustainable development.

He said that the time had passed for racing circuits and massive trans-national tourism infrastructure projects, that benefit a handful of economic actors rather than the population as a whole. Instead, Governments keen to build back better after COVID-19 should focus on empowering local communities, enhancing livelihoods and participation in decision-making, he continued, urging investors not to finance or engage in projects and activities, that contribute to human rights violations and abuses.

In addition to Mr De Schutter, the UN experts making the call include the special rapporteurs on the rights of indigenous peoples, on the situation of human rights defenders and on adequate housing; the independent experts on human rights and international solidarity and on promotion of a democratic and equitable international order, as well as, the members of the UN Working Group on business and human rights.

The Special Rapporteurs, Independent Experts and Working Groups are part of what is known as the Special Procedures of the Human Rights Council. The experts work on a voluntary basis; they are not UN staff and do not receive a salary. They are independent from any government or organisation and serve in their individual capacity.

|| Africa || Central African Republic: UN Special Rapporteurs Concerned Over Russian Advisers and Their Close Contacts With UN Peace-Keepers ||



|| Wednesday: March 31: 2021 || á. UN Special Rapporteurs raised concerns over the recruitment and use of private military and foreign security contractors by the Government of the Central African Republic and their apparent close contacts with UN peace-keepers there. Tensions have been high in CAR since before the presidential elections were held on December 27, 2020 and widespread volatility remains, amid attacks by a coalition of armed groups.

“This blurring of the lines between civil, military and peace-keeping operations during the hostilities, creates confusion about the legitimate targets and increases the risks for widespread human rights and humanitarian law abuses., said the UN Special Rapporteurs. Their alert focuses on the interconnected roles of Sewa Security Services, Russian-owned Lobaye Invest SARLU and a Russian-based organisation, known as, the Wagner Group.

They said that they were disturbed to learn of the close working relationship between contractors and the United Nations peace-keeping mission in CAR, MINUSCA. In particular, they expressed concerns about contractors’ connections to a series of violent attacks since the nationwide poll.

They said that they had received and continue to receive, reports of grave human rights abuses and violations of international humanitarian law, attributable to the private military personnel, operating jointly with CAR’s armed forces:FACA and in some instances UN peace-keepers.

Among the violations are reports of mass summary executions, arbitrary detentions, torture during interrogations, forced disappearances, forced displacement of the civilian population, indiscriminate targeting of civilian facilities, violations of the right to health and increasing attacks on humanitarian actors.

They pointed to the presence of Russian advisers at MINUSCA bases, as well as, medical evacuations of wounded Russian trainers to the UN mission's bases. In a call to the Government and their international partners to comply with their obligations under international law, the UN Special Rapporteurs urged them to hold accountable all perpetrators of grave violations and abuses of human rights.

"Unacceptably, there seem to be no investigations and no accountability for these abuses. The close connections between the various actors, along with the lack of transparency, further jeopardises chances of any impartial investigation and ensuring accountability for those abuses and violations."

"Greater clarity on the roles of these international partners and accountability is needed to achieve sustainable peace and stability in Central African Republic." UN Special Rapporteurs said.

|| United Kingdom || £200 Million Port Infrastructure Fund Opens for Bids ||



|| Wednesday: March 31: 2021 || á. The UK government is ramping up its preparations for the end of the transition period with the launch of a £200 million fund for ports to build new facilities. New infrastructure at ports will be needed whether or not the UK secures a negotiated agreement with the EU as the UK leaves the Customs Union and Single Market and new procedures will be coming into place.

The Fund is targeted at those ports, that have the space to build new border infrastructure on their current sites so that they are ready to handle new customs requirements under the new Border Operating Model. The funding can be used for a range of vital port infrastructure from warehouses and control posts to traffic management systems. The deadline for applications is midday on October 30, with successful bids announced shortly after.

Where infrastructure is not best situated at ports, the government has allocated an additional £270 million to build inland customs facilities. Recognising the impact of coronavirus on businesses' ability to prepare, the UK has taken the decision to introduce new border controls in three stages up until July 01, 2021. This flexible and pragmatic approach will give industry extra time to make necessary arrangements.

The stages are: In force from January 2021: Traders importing standard goods, covering everything from clothes to electronics, will need to prepare for basic customs requirements, such as, keeping sufficient records of imported goods and will have up to six months to complete customs declarations. While tariffs will need to be paid on all imports, payments can be deferred until the

customs declaration has been made. There will be checks on controlled goods like alcohol and tobacco. Businesses will, also, need to consider how they account for VAT on imported goods. There will, also, be physical checks at the point of destination or other approved premises on all high risk live animals and plants.

From April 2021: All products of animal origin:POAO, for example, meat, pet food, honey, milk or egg products and all regulated plants and plant products will require pre-notification and the relevant health documentation.

From July 2021: Traders moving all goods will have to make declarations at the point of importation and pay relevant tariffs. Full Safety and Security declarations will be required, while for SPS commodities there will be an increase in physical checks and the taking of samples: checks for animals, plants and their products will now take place at GB Border Control Posts.

The opening of the fund has been welcomed by industry and will see ports accelerate their preparations for the end of the year, as well as, give industry confidence that all required infrastructure will be delivered on time.

The Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster, Mr Michael Gove MP, said, "With just three months to go until the end of the UK transition period, businesses need to prepare now for the new procedures that will come into place whether or not we reach a trade agreement with the EU, so that we can seize the significant opportunities that lie ahead."

The Secretary of State for Transport, Mr Grant Shapps MP, said, "Our ports are a point of pride for the UK, contributing to our success as a global trading nation and helping bring vital goods into the country each and every day. This investment will not only ensure our borders are fully operational at the end of the transition period, but will also support the UK's fantastic businesses as they trade across Europe."

Mr Tim Morris of the UK Major Ports Group, the Trade Association for the UK's largest port operators, said, "There is significant port capacity around the coast of the UK for handling freight flows to and from the EU. Today's announcement is a welcome step in ensuring that this capacity can be maximised and UK supply chains can be more resilient."

Mr Richard Ballantyne, the Chief Executive of the British Ports Association, which represents ports, that facilitate 86% of the trade, including, all the UK's main roll-on roll-off gateways, said, "We welcome this fund and the focus on preparing port infrastructure for what will need accommodate a significant change in our trading relationship with the EU. It's clear that without support there would not be the capacity to deal the new customs and borders requirements. We therefore welcome this scheme which importantly will be open to all port operators across Great Britain."

|| United Kingdom || Around One in Three Key Workers Earn Less Than £10 an Hour: TUC Analysis: Calling Any Figure a Living Wage Does Not Make It So: £08.91 Is Absolutely Not Living Wage ||



|| Wednesday: March 31: 2021 || $\acute{\alpha}$. Around one in three key workers, 33%, earn less than £10 an hour according to a new analysis by the TUC, published today. The analysis, published ahead the new national living wage:NLW and national minimum wage:NMW rates coming into force tomorrow, Thursday, April 01, shows that around 03.2 million key workers are paid less than £10 an hour.

This makes it harder to pay bills and put food on the table, says the TUC. Key workers, being paid less than £10 an hour include retail workers: three-quarters, 75%, of retail workers are paid less than £10 an hour. That's around one million retail assistants, cashiers and shelf fillers.

More than three in five, 62%, 440,000, carers earn under £10 an hour. Nearly seven in 10, 69%, 340,000 teaching and education support assistants are paid less than £10 an hour.

The TUC argues that all key workers deserve a decent pay rise as they have been expected to continue to work throughout lockdown and local restrictions, during the height of the pandemic.

The union body says that retail workers have been keeping essential shops going, often, in conditions, that don't allow for proper social distancing. And care workers have been looking after some of the most vulnerable and putting themselves at risk to do so.

TUC General Secretary Ms Frances O'Grady said, "Our shop assistants, carers and school support staff have worked around the clock to keep the country going through the pandemic, often, at great personal risk to their health. But those, expecting a decent pay increase tomorrow have been let down by the government's decision to row back on the full rise they were promised.

Ministers must get the minimum wage up to £10 an hour to stop millions of working people from living in poverty."

NLW and NMW rates: The hourly rate for the minimum wage depends on age and whether one is an apprentice. One must be, at least, school leaving age to get the National Minimum Wage. And from Thursday, April 01, workers will receive the National Living Wage from age 23.

This is why it is paramount that that we speak up and out and try our hardest to inspire faith, hope, determination and resolution among all humanity of this world, women and men, that we shall not just accept this ‘sentence of doom’, that capitalism’s mindless consumerism, infinite greed of infinite profiteering, decadent vogueism and venomous voyeurism, orchestrated by the Distorteddia have brought us and, yet, that we can, we should, we ought, we must keep on trying: ‘to seek to try: to do: to change: to make better the human condition’ and we do so as one humanity, as women and men, working together as one, in unison with the same aim, same goal, same objective: to get all humanity to liberty, equality, fairness and justice in the rule of law in natural justice, with a purpose and meaning to our existence, where we all humanity, with our all-unity and all-diversity, exist as one humanity naturale on one Mother Earth, in one Sunnara, in one Home Bay Milky Way Galaxy in the one Universana with the humanical foundation of faith: humanity is an infinity unfolding itself, in which, we are all-for-one and one-for-all.
