A monthly average of 11,500 people, travelling from the Horn of Africa to Yemen last year, made the so-called Eastern Route the busiest maritime migration path on earth, according to the International Organisation for Migration:IOM. The Agency states that most are unaware of the security situation in Yemen where they face serious protection concerns, including, active fighting or abuses, such as, kidnapping, torture for ransom, exploitation and trafficking.

This very fact that, despite the war and conflicts going on in Yemen for many years, people are using this route to get out of their places of origin and getting in the war-torn country, where people are far more desperate than the ones coming to them, goes to show how desperate people are attempting to escape their reality, that they find and see as 'the trap'. It does not matter what awaits on route or wherever they end up, these desperate humanity are not thinking of that but seeking to escape that 'trap', that forces them to seek to escape. However, for many, that ends up creating tragedies and will continue to do so. And the world keeps on ignoring and looking away. Every now and then, agencies, like IOM, presents statistics and, well, everybody says, "Tragic! What a waste of human lives!" Etc! Etc and everyone moves on! Though, tragic it is and it ought to be responded to properly as humanity should and ought to do: humanity of this world.

The world can not keep on looking away. It can not keep on ignoring these vital problems. There are many places, hundreds of them, on earth, where conflicts, violence, war and general falling apart of state and government infrastructures means that for people there's no security, there's no safety nor there is hope of seeing things ever getting better or that they will be able to get a living for their families. Lawlessness, inter-communal conflicts, religious tensions and hatred, gangs, drug cartels, violence and injury and deaths add to that sense of desperation and fuels this drive to try and 'escape' the 'trap'. 'Violent and chronic' poverty is one of the determining factors in a great number of places, from where people are being 'driven' outward to seek, search, find and achieve simply 'bread'.

Richer countries on the other side are willing to look away and keep themselves 'protected' from these on-coming flow of 'illegal migrants, 'illegal immigrants, 'asylum seekers' etc by seeking to keep their borders shut and in their efforts to keep that 'hole' blocked, through which these 'unwanted' are coming through, so that they can not reach their borders and in these attempts they short-change all their so-called 'high-morals' and pay whoever would accept the money and do that work. European Union is such a Party.

Yet, no one can stop these flows and, thus, these constant-flowing existence of dangers keep on costing human lives, which are costing too many human beings losing their lives now and, those, who are not losing their lives, great many are falling into many kinds of abuses, attacks, violence, slavery, tortures and rapes, sex and human trafficking etc. Slave markets are up and running in

this horrendous world, once again! The world must work together to create a positive, proactive, compassionate and humanitarian response to try and resolve these problems at the source. This problem can only be resolved at the source, where the problem is created, sustained and maintained.

The richer countries of the world must come forward and create an international framework, a permanent one at that, under the United Nations, so that these countries, from where desperate people are rushing out, are supported in creating viable, practical and solid socio-economic structures and means for people to get employment in their countries and through that work they begin to rebuild their lives and, thus, their economies and countries. This is the only way to deal with these real issues for the longer term so that no human soul is lost in attempting these dangerous journeys, often, ending in tragedies. Further, once, these initiatives are up and running things will begin to change. But this is not a 'charity thing': it is an international humanity thing, legal and binding thing. It is hard work not just money is enough: it shall require the Security Council, taking a newer and 'executive' kind of a 'hands on approach' so that these works and projects get to be the highest most in the UN agenda, every day!

This means that the world's richer countries put up financial resources to fund UN Work for Regeneration Projects, under the leadership, guidance and protection of the UN in places, like Libya and many other places in Africa, Asia and South America. These projects would enable a 'sanctuary' to these fleeing humanity to find a place to stop, get employment and with that employment build infrastructures for their countries and with that work they rebuild their lives, their family lives and their communal lives. These are the kind of longer-term, positive and pro-active interventions from the world, that can and will make lasting impact so that these people will not only have employment but the means to create things and infrastructures, that will keep on sustaining their communities.

As already said, these initiatives must be done under the international law and under the direct supervision of the Security Council so that in a given country, the Security Council mandates the force necessary to create a UN mini-protectorate in a project-country, where it shelters people from any war, conflict, violence and from there it supports and enable them to build and that building things and structures are their employment and way towards peace. We are not speaking of 'refugee camps' or giving out of 'vouchers' or food and

drink or clothes. We are speaking of the protectorate showing a nano-state, nano-government and nano-infrastructure building'. A place, few thousand people and they begin work. They build houses for the people there and they begin living there. They build schools and nurseries and they send their children there. They teach teachers there as they build their schools. They educate their doctors and train their nurses as they build their hospitals and roads and markets. This is the way to begin changing the battered corners of earth, that are rebuilt by the people, given a humanitarian, compassionate and positive lending hand. These are the things, that these broken down, devastated and destroyed places and their people need and these are the things, that will begin a revolution from the oasis of these protectorates: hope shall spread and inspire people across the world. Close the rupture to stop the blood gushing out: Nothing else, no plastering will do: these problems must be dealt with at the source and the world humanity can no longer keep on doing nothing!

Give people employment, necessary education and training, give them the means to earn a living and support their families, support their children's life and education etc and see how desperately they come to stay in their own communities. People can not exist and stay put in absolute and infinite desolation of eternal despair and dilapidation of hope and in the burning desperation of 'violent and chronic' poverty. They will forever keep on seeking to rush and run out and suffer and pay the price while the rest of the world can not escape the problems, that that create.

Rationality shows us the 'outside world' can not accommodate the entire population of the world at the other side from where people are rushing out. Whole of Asia can not get to Europe and America or whole of Africa can not get to Europe or America. Whole south America can not get to north America. It is not possible. The world, therefore, must rise to see and accept this and begin work to offer something tangible, real and solid for these people to build things up from the scratch.

Small beginning but big prospect. This is the only way the world ought to, should and must respond, positively, proactively and definitively than just sitting on the fence, ignoring and looking away. These problems have been going on for decades and increasing too fast, too far and too wide. These can not be ignored any longer. The world and world humanity must rise to these challenges and do something: positive, proactive and definitive to offer solid,

tangible and life-giving to the humanity, struggling to survive and stop these tragic and needless deaths and human suffering.

::“While tragedies along the Mediterranean routes are well reported, our staff bear witness daily to the abuse, suffered by young people from the Horn of Africa at the hands of smugglers and traffickers exploiting their hopes for a better life.” said Mr Mohammed Abdiker, IOM Regional Director for the East and Horn of Africa.

After five years of conflict in Yemen, the Eastern Route has spiked as travellers appear undeterred by the Gulf’s strict immigration policies for undocumented migrants. Data collected by IOM’s Displacement Tracking Matrix showed that over 138,000 people crossed the Gulf of Aden to Yemen last year, as compared to the more than 110,000 migrants and refugees, who crossed the Mediterranean Sea to Europe during that same period.

And this is the second year in a row that the Eastern Route reported more crossings than the Mediterranean. In 2018, roughly, 150,000 people made the journey. “To get to Yemen, they crammed about 280 of us into one boat.” a thirty-two-year-old Ethiopian man told IOM in Aden, Yemen. “There was no oxygen and some people committed suicide by throwing themselves into the sea.”

An eighteen-year-old Ethiopian migrant said, “We were beaten, tortured, abused and threatened for ransom. My family sent \$900 to save my life so I was released.” Those making the perilous journey, crossing deserts and territories controlled by armed groups, with little food or water, either travel in search of economic opportunities or are fleeing insecurity, human rights abuses and adverse living conditions.

Approximately, 92 per cent of those, who disembarked in Yemen were Ethiopian nationals, the vast majority of whom aimed to continue to Saudi Arabia. Smugglers and traffickers operate boats from Obock in Djibouti and Bosasso in Somalia. Last year, 38 per cent of migrants arrived from Djibouti and 62 per cent from Somalia.

The journeys from their home to Saudi Arabia can take months or, even, longer, depending on whether they stop to work or are detained along the way. While IOM works across the Horn of Africa and the Arabian Gulf to provide life-

saving emergency support to migrants in need and support development in home communities, the agency maintains, that legal pathways for migration are the most effective protection mechanism for migrants.” :: news.un.org/en/story/2020/02/1057411
